THE FENIANS AGAIN. The Fenians will attack Canada in force within a few days or weeks, and make a bold effort to conquer the country. Foundries have been cutting shot and cannons for them for weeks, a large number of muskets, &c. are in store along the border, and at least 50,000 men are ready to strike for liberty and Ireland at the word "go." That is one side of the story—the N. Y. Herald says. On the reverse we have statements from American papers, just as likely to be well informed, that these rumors are entirely without foundation, and that there is no prospect of an invasion this summer. It seems, however, that some information reached Toronto on Wednesday which led to orders being issued for troops to be in readiness to start for the frontier if required. No doubt our Government will be on the alert, and fully prepared for any emergency that may suddenly arise.

SEAPORTH. 3rd June, 1867. Incorporation.—The ratifiers of the Bill for the incorporation of the Fenian Brotherhood in this province have had a meeting on Tuesday night to take the vote of the people, but they did not come to a conclusion, and adjourned till Friday night, when a large number of the ratifiers met at a crowded house. The principal speakers were Messrs. McDougall, Hill, and Logan for incorporation—Messrs. Coleman, Dickson and Campbell against it. Those for it argued that if they could incorporate they would have their taxes to improve the town which is much needed (it) instead of building roads and bridges in the townships. They had paid \$100 in 1865, and only about \$20 were expected in 1867. They also mentioned that their taxes would be less. Those against it said that it was rather too soon to incorporate, that it would be more prudent to remain in connection with the townships for a year or two at least. They cited all the arguments of their opponents but the last said that Clinton (with an assessment very little more than Seaporth) paid \$1000 in taxes for the year 1865, and Seaporth paid only \$400 the same year, a vote was taken which resulted in 6 of a majority against incorporation.
