APPS LOOKING FOR PEACE

Have Seen Only Failure Reached the Mikado and Reached the Czar.

London, Nov. 10.—Japan unofficially has made representations to Russia looking to peace.

The proposition was put forward tentatively and unofficially, so that the Japanese government would be in a position to deny any report that it was going to peace.

The failure of these direct negotiations, however, resulted in bringing in mediation by the United States.

Foreign Secretary Lansdowne's plan of mediation was accepted at the Guildhall banquet taken here to be a pointed suggestion to the United States.

The Russian government has not yet accepted a proposition looking to peace.

Lord Lansdowne's remarks are held to be a definite impression here that the initiative will come from President Roosevelt.

It is mooted that Lord Lansdowne only spoke so openly yesterday evening because he had good reason to believe that Mr. Roosevelt will co-operate.

It is known, however, that Mr. Roosevelt is not participating in his work as assiduously as he had hoped.
