

An Act to incorporate the Union St. Jean Baptiste of the village of St. Jean Baptiste, in the parish of Montreal.

WHEREAS an Association under the name of the Union of St. Jean Baptiste, has existed for some time past, in the village of St. Jean Baptiste, in the parish of Montreal, having for its object the aid of its 5 members in case of sickness, and the ensuring of like assistance and other advantages to the widows and children of deceased members; And whereas the members of the said Association have prayed to be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant their petition: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:—

- 20 tiste, of the village of St. Jean Baptiste, and by that name shall have real property power from time to time, and at any time hereafter, to purchase, acquire, limitedpossess, hold, exchange, accept and receive for themselves and their successors, all lands, tenements and hereditaments, and all real or immoveable estate, being and situated in Lower Canada, necessary for the make by-law
- 25 actual use and occupation of the said Corporation, and the said property to hypothecate, sell, alienate and dispose of, and to acquire other instead thereof for the same purposes; and any majority of the said Corporation, for the time being, shall have full power and authority to make and establish such rules, regulations and by-laws, in no respect inconsistent
- 30 with this Act, nor with the laws then in force in Lower Canada, as they may deem expedient and necessary for the interests and administration of the affairs of the said Corporation, and for the admission of members thereof: and the same to amend and repeal, from time to time, in whole or in part, and also such regulations and by-laws as may be in force at
- 35 the time of the passing of this Act; such majority may also execute and Forther administer, or cause to be executed and administered, all and every the nowers of other business and matters appertaining to the said Corporation, and to majority. the government and management thereof, in so far as the same may come under their control, respect being nevertheless had to the regula-
- 40 tions, stipulations, provisions and by-laws to be hereafter passed and established.

2. Provided always, that the rents, revenues and profits arising out Appropriaof every description of moveable property belonging to the said Corpo- tain purpusar ration, shall be appropriated and employed exclusively for the benefit only. 45 of the members of the said Corporation, and for the erection and repair of the buildings necessary for the purposes of the said Corporation, and for the payment of expenses legitimately incurred in carrying out any of the objects above referred to.

All real and personal estate, at present the property of the said Association Association, or which may hereafter be acquired by the members there-5 transferred to of in their capacity as such, by purchase, donation or otherwise, and Corporation. all debts, claims, and rights which they may be possessed of in such capacity shall be, and they are hereby transferred to the Corporation constituted by this Act, and the said Corporation shall be charged with all the liabilities and obligations of the said Association, and the rules, 10 Also liabiliregulations and by-laws now or hereafter to be established for the manties. agement of the said Association, shall be and continue to be the rules, regulations and by-laws of the said Corporation, until altered or repealed in the manner prescribed by this Act. Corporation 4. The members of the said Corporation, for the time being, or the 15 to appoint majority of them, shall have power to appoint administrators or man-Officers, &c. agers for the administration of the property of the Corporation, and such officers, managers, administrators or servants of the said Corporation, as may be required for the due management of the affairs thereof, and to allow to them respectively a reasonable and suitable remunera- 20 tion; and all officers so appointed shall have the right to exercise such other powers and authorities for the due management and administration of the affairs of the said Corporation, as may be conferred upon them by the regulations and by-laws of thesaid Corporation.

Aunual R port to the Legislature. 5. The said Corporation shall be bound to make annual Reports to 25 both branches of the Legislature, containing a general statement of the affairs of the Corporation, which said reports shall be presented within the first twenty days of every Session of the Legislature.

Public Act. 6. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
