FEDERAL PROCEEDINGS IN SALEM.

FRIDAY EVENING, MARCH 30, 1810.

A Meeting of the Federal Republicans at Washington-Hall, JACOB ASHTON, Esq. Moderator, Mr. JOHN JENKS, Secretary—

Voted, That the following persons (agreeably to a recommendation of the Ward Committees) be distributors of Votes in and about the Court-House on the day of Election :

From Ward No. I.—Josiah Dow, Benja. Hawkes, Gideon Tucker, Samuel Upton, Willm. Ramfiddell, Samuel Peabody.

From Ward No. II.—John Babbidge, E. Hervey Derby, Philip Chaic, Ebenezer Putnam, John Gardner jun. Benjamin Aderton, Pelatiah Brown, David Lord jun.

From Ward No. III.—Andrew Jaraden, William Mugford, Joseph Woodberry, Pickering Dodge, Benjamin Peirce, Samuel G. Derby, John Dodge, Charles Saunders, Joseph Baker.

From Ward No. IV.—John Barr, Joseph Andrews, John Derby, Benjamin H. Hathorne, Jery Lee Page, Abraham Fos jun. Joseph Felt, Charles Parker, Jonathan Waldo jun. Samuel Rea.

Voted—That in addition to the foregoing, all who have heretofore exerted themselves to bring Votes to the Poll, be requested to continue their exertions at the ensuing Election, to bring forward those who will support the Federal Ticket—and “receive their reward in the thankfulness of nations.”

The arrangements of the Election having been completed, the following RESOLUTIONS were read as declaratory of the sense of the Meeting, and unanimously adopted :—

RESOLVED,

THAT experience has demonstrated the policy of MADISON to be equally hostile as that of his predecessor, to the best interests of our country—and, that an administration, who surrender the independence of their country by submitting to the insulting mandates of the *Despot of France*, betray the trust reposed in them by their constituents.

Resolved, That the man who can tamely speak of the outrageous conduct of France, in burning our ships on the ocean, and burying our citizens in French dungeons, only “*trespasses*” upon our rights, has not the sense of honour and patriotism which the people of the United States demand in their Chief Magistrate.

Resolved, That when the administration of the General Government shall betray our trust, the only safety of the people rests in the State Governments—and, to prevent the fatal consequences of such treachery, it is our duty to place in our State Offices men whom we can rely with confidence for the protection of the unalienable rights of life, liberty and property.

Resolved, That we will support by all honourable and constitutional means, as
