OF THE

Halifax Ladies' Bible Association.

Another year having elapsed since the issue of our last Report reminds us of the rapid flight of time, and of the necessity of working "while it is called to-day," ever remembering, that, "the night cometh when no man can work." The fact of one and another of our fellow-labourers having been called away during the year just passed, should impress the reality of this truth upon the hearts and minds of those who are left.

Mrs. E. Binney, one of the early originators of this Society, has been removed by death since we sent forth our last Report. She ever took a lively interest in the work, and left the sum of \$400 towards it in her will.

We have also to record the death of Mrs. Jas. Thomson, who was one of our faithful collectors, and who will be much missed. The Bible Woman's work goes on as formerly. She took no vacation during the summer, but remained at her post.

In her half-yearly Report sent in to the Committee in November last, she speaks of much encouragement, and although still finding ignorance and gross darkness among the people she has to deal with, notwithstanding all their advantages, yet the special efforts put forth in the city during the summer, have led to a very real and earnest spirit of seeking after the truth, and in many cases her heart has been cheered by manifest signs, among those who formerly were careless, of anxiety in regard to their

souls, and by the happy change in others who were great sinners, and have now found the Saviour. For a record of the Bible Woman's work during the past winter, we refer our readers to her Report.

We trust that many hearts may be inclined to give, as they are able, towards this good cause, not forgetting that, "If there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not."

BIBLE WOMAN'S REPORT.

To the Committee of the Ladies' Bible Society :

It is with feelings of gratitude to God for the very many mercies of another year, that I present this my report, and in doing so I would thank God that I have found Him to be true to His promises, that grace has been given me according to my day, and that I have been enabled to point many to the dear Saviour, and have been enabled to rejoice with them, who have found Him to be so precious to their souls. A young woman whom I visited during her last illness died fully trusting in Jesus, while others are still living Christian lives and seem so different now; truly a new song has been put in their mouths. A woman who was a victim to strong drink for years, I have visited, and she signed the pledge several times and broke it; but during the last four months has kept sober and is striving to be a Christian, as a consequence other members of the family have attended our Mothers' Meeting and have been blessed. There has been much sickness this year and very many out of employment, which makes it hard for those who would be ashamed to beg; some have had work in the stone shed, which has been a help. I have distributed over 3,000 tracts and papers. Every family I have visited during the year was provided with a Bible, but seldom read, judging by the way it was put aside in many cases, and the owners seemed surprised when I read to them, to find that such things were within.

There is an increased desire among the people to read the Word which is very encouraging. I have paid 1,803 visits. At the end of this month we close our Mothers' Meeting which has been well attended since the new year. There is reason for thankfulness that some have been blessed during these meetings.
