Shipping News. New Zealand—A handsome modelled bark named Chocoma arrived at this port this morning from Hantsport, N. S., at which port she was built. She is commanded by Mr. John Melick, and has been chartered to Lord Lambton for Great Britain.

Great Case. Sherwood vs. St. John's has ended at last and a verdict has been returned giving the title in the plaintiff and giving nominal damages.

Liston et al vs. Miller was next taken up and being decided a verdict of \$215.45 was found for the plaintiff. The action was on a dishonored Bill of Exchange. Mr. Doherty, attorney, and Mr. McLeod, counsel, for the plaintiff.

This afternoon the case of the E. & N. A. Railway Co. vs. James L. Dunn was taken up. It is an action to recover the value of stock alleged to be subscribed by the defendant, but repudiated by him. The case has been on the docket two or three years. The case will be tried by a Coroner's jury, the Sheriff being a stockholder in the railway company. Before the jury was called the Chief Justice discovered that the case on the nisi prius record was to the Sheriff instead of the Coroner, and stated that the case could not be tried on that record unless by consent of the defendant. The consent of the defendant was given, and the trial was proceeded with. Mr. Palmer for the plaintiff and Mr. Duff for the defendant.

Portland Civil Court. Quite a number of cases were disposed of at the Portland Civil Court this morning, including three of the Glass Blowers' cases, in which judgment against the defendants was taken by default. Some others were postponed as it was thought there would be a settlement.

Another case of interest was that of Savage vs. Kyle in which the plaintiff sought to recover rent for premises hired by the defendant. At the time of the bargain the defendant was anticipating marriage, and believing in the principle of securing the case before getting the bird arranged with the plaintiff for apartments. The marriage took place, but in the meantime the wife, on visiting the premises, objected to making her home there, and as a consequence the defendant did not take possession. A part of the rent had been paid in advance, and the suit was for the recovery of the balance. The defence was that Mr. Kyle had been furnished or otherwise taken formal possession, and that the money paid in advance was sufficient to compensate the plaintiff for any disappoinment. The judgment was for the defendant. Mr. John Kerr, who appeared for the plaintiff, expressed his intention to appeal.

The Trial of Rogers Postponed.

At the opening of the Circuit Court this morning, Mr. John Kerr submitted an affidavit made by Archibald Rogers asking for a postponement of his trial. The affidavit alleged that DeMill, who was with Rogers at the time of the shooting, is a material and necessary witness, and that he could not safely proceed to trial without him; that since his incarceration he has caused enquiry to be made, and is informed and believes that DeMill is in Boston, and that his attendance can be procured if time is allowed for the purpose.

The Attorney General, on behalf of the Crown, stated that he had no desire to postpone the application, if the trial could be arranged to take place at the latter part of the present circuit.

The Chief Justice remarked that Rogers should have done as he recommended him at the time of arraignment and taken steps to have DeMill in attendance. The affidavit did not show that any effort had yet been made. He was, however, desirous that every man should have a fair trial, and particularly this man whose life hung in the balance. In order to allow an opportunity for Rogers to have his defence in readiness he would consent to leave the trial deferred until the latter part of the circuit.

This will make the time of the trial about ten days hence.
