MORE CABINET CHANGES. JOHN O'DONOHUE IN THE SENATE AND GOVERNMENT. What the Reporters Learned About the Cabinet Changes.

EAST END CONSERVATIVES

AT LAST SETTLE ON JOHN SMALL AS STANDARD BARRER.

Seven More Ballots Taken - W. B. Scarth Runs Him Hard - A Majority Vote Adopted.

About 7.30 last night the Eastern temperance hall began to be crowded by conservative delegates from East Toronto. None but delegates were admitted. At 9 p.m. the meeting was called to order by the chairman, Hon. Alexander Morris. Roll was then called and substitutes appointed for absent members. Dr. McCollum and Mr. Beeve were appointed scrutineers.

Seven ballots were taken before a decision could be arrived at. The first ballot stood thus -

- Small 49, Scarth 34, Davin 18, Lobb 9. The second thus - Small 52, Scarth 38, Davin 11, Lobb 6.

The fourth - Small 45, Scarth 50, Davin 11, Lobb 6.

After the fourth ballot Hon. Alex. Morris was nominated, but as he said he had a duty to perform in the local legislature he declined.

The fifth ballot stood as follows - Small 51, Scarth 52, Davin 4, Lobb 3. At this point Nicholas of the Flood withdrew and a motion was carried to drop out the lowest name, viz., Mr. Lobb, thus leaving the contest between Mr. Small and Mr. Scarth.

The sixth ballot was a tie, each candidate polling 35 votes.

A motion was here brought forward to add new nominees, as it seemed impossible to get a two-thirds majority with the two then running. An amendment was made to take two more ballots, and an amendment to the amendment that as both the candidates had an equal number of votes, and they were the parties most interested, the matter be left to them as to who shall contest the riding. The original motion was carried.

Ald. Boswell and Clarke were then nominated in addition to Small and Scarth. As it was getting late, the morning was coming around, and it was resolved to decide the matter by a majority vote instead of a two-thirds vote, that is the candidate who would draw the highest at the first ballot should be nominated.

The final ballot stood Small 54, Scarth 48, Boswell 2. At 1.30 this morning Small was unanimously declared the candidate. Mr. Small was then sent for and addressed the meeting.

A CRANK WITH A REVOLVER.

He Draws It on a Saloon Keeper and a Policeman.

The carrying of firearms appears to be again almost a general custom, and as a consequence every few days a witness of a shooting case. A short time ago a young street merchant had a narrow escape from becoming the victim of one of those cranks, and yesterday afternoon a similar case occurred in front of the Woodbine hotel, Yonge street. A tall boy by the name of Wm. Maloney, in a semi-intoxicated state, entered the saloon, and after causing considerable disturbance, he was ejected by the proprietor, Lem. Felcher. Apparently not liking this treatment, Maloney drew a revolver, but without attempting to use it returned it to his pocket, remarking that no policeman would arrest him while he had this in his pocket. Policeman Gregory happened to come along at this time, made an effort to arrest the tall man, who drew his revolver and again shot at him. He was happily the weapon missed his mark. After this attempt the would-be murderer took to his heels followed by Gregory who called Constables Armstrong, Robinson and Somerville to his assistance. A long chase ensued but finally Maloney was captured at the upper part of a building at the corner of Yonge and Adelaide streets. Although he felt like sending his captors to eternity, the sight of four blue coats had the desired effect, and he offered no further resistance. He was taken to No. 1 police station where he stated that his only reason for taking the revolver from his breast pocket was for the purpose of putting it into his hip pocket. The prisoner is a young man of about 25 years of age, and was considerably under the influence of liquor when arrested. The weapon is a small silver mounted five-shot revolver, every chamber of which proved to be loaded. He will be compelled to interview his worship this morning when he will be charged with an attempt to shoot Gregory, and with carrying firearms.

The Reform Amplitheater.

Foster was a late resident of Yorkville, and prominent member of the Bloor street church, but becoming involved he made over to the church enough property to satisfy his indebtedness in that direction, and then left the country. The chancellor gave judgment at 10 o'clock yesterday, dismissing the action with costs.

The first annual meeting of the shareholders of the Toronto paper manufacturing company was held at their offices, No. 68 Church street, Toronto, on Wednesday, May 31, at 3 o'clock p.m. The president, Mr. J. A. Barber, occupied the chair, and on motion, Mr. C. Blackett Robinson was appointed secretary. After receiving receiving report of progress, and in synopsis of the company's buildings at Cornwall, the following directors were unanimously elected: Messrs J. A. Barber (Georgetown), W. G. Gage, C. Blackett Robinson, W. W. Copp, B. Brown, E. Trout, and Geo. Macdonald (Cornwall). At a subsequent meeting of the board Mr. J. A. Barber was re-elected president, Mr. W. J. Gage, vice-president, and Mr. E. Trout, secretary-treasurer.

IRISH IMMIGRANTS.

Two Hundred in Toronto with no Work and Little Money.

The tide of immigration from Ireland has set in, about two hundred immigrants having arrived Tuesday night from the land of the green soil. Nearly all are from the county of Wexford. They appear to be entirely ignorant as to what their future course will be, as they are almost entirely unacquainted with the requirements of laborers in Canada, and it is probable that the majority of the men will find employment on the railways in course of construction, while an effort will be made to provide the girls with situations as domestic servants. Although as a rule the immigrants are comfortably clad they will suffer much from the want of money, of which they appear to have a very scanty supply. The girls are dressed in the usual costume of the Irish peasant girl, and the men are clothed in pilot coats and corduroy pants and vest. They, one and all, complain bitterly of their treatment by the landlords, and stated that had they been used differently they would never have left "ould Ireland." Mr. Donahoe is doing all he possibly can to reconcile them to their lot, and a number of railway officials and others have visited the immigrants, and it is probable that in the course of a few days all will be nearly settled and quieted.

OSCAR AND THE GIRLS.

He Teaches a Ladies School in Hamilton. Oscar Wilde visited the Wesleyan Ladies college in Hamilton yesterday on the invitation of Dr. Burns, and delivered an address on "The relation of art to other studies." All the students as well as the faculty were present, to the number of about 100. Mr. Wilde's address was well received and was remarkable for its judicious warning and excellent philosophy. He stated that it was the first time he had ever addressed an audience of ladies. He was pleased to have such an opportunity, and hoped that when he again visited Canada he would find all the colleges and universities thrown open to ladies, and that all the degrees would be conferred upon them. [Applause.]

A motion was made for judgment yesterday to sign final judgment and judgment was reserved, but as the mistake was not in any way to the plaintiff, it seems likely that the motion will succeed.

GOLDWIN SMITH.

His Opinion on the Canadian Elections. The Government will be Sustained. Mr. Goldwin Smith, writing from Oxford on May 19, and after just having heard that the Canadian elections had been ordered, writes:

"After the great financial successes of government, it probably will be sustained in the Dominion elections. If it is, as a liberal, shall not be sorry, though I look forward to better things hereafter. Nothing can be less liberal than criticism of the despotism of literary thugs. I trust, however, that places will be found for one or two men of independent character, honest to no service but that of the Canadian people. Their presence in the legislature would be of the utmost value to the nation."
