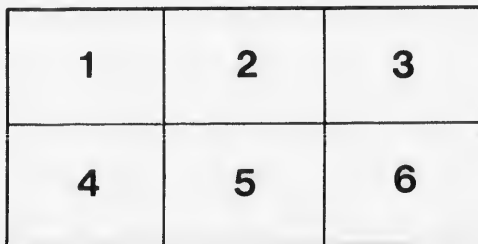
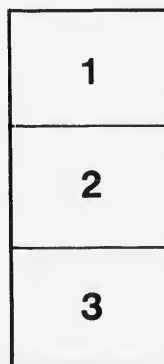

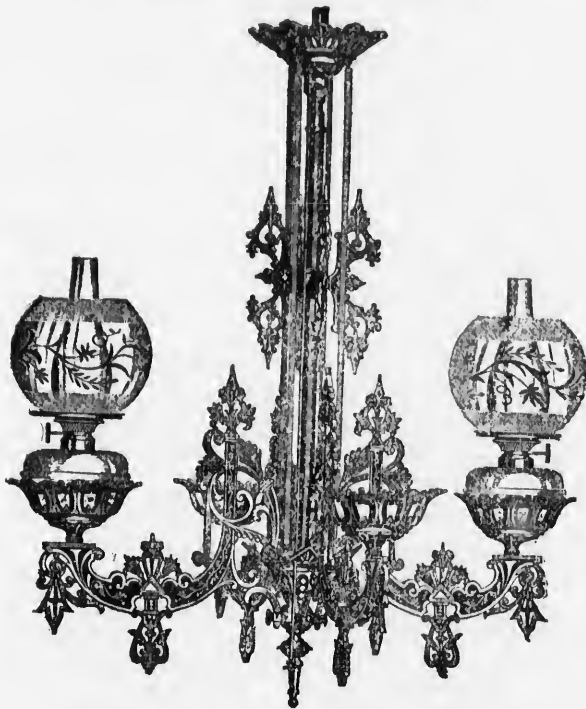

NOTES AND HINTS.

The work of the Baptist Book and Tract Society is to publish, import, and distribute books by sales and otherwise. We wish to elevate the character of our general literature, and provide for our Sabbath schools and families, such reading, as shall be *in all respects*, in harmony with the Word of God. "If Baptists yield their ground in the Sunday school on Bible and gospel doctrines and ordinances, by allowing this flood of undenominational literature to cover up all traces of our views, the next generation will witness the folly of our course, in the rapid decline of Baptist sentiments, and in the decay of our Church life; by the absence of all those vital teachings that distinguish us from the offspring of the Romish Hierarchy."—Rev. M. D. Cage in *Herald of Truth*.

"A Baptist Sunday School should teach Baptist doctrines; should train up its children to be intelligent in what the denomination believes. Its belief is founded upon the Word of God; its doctrines are those of the Bible, and therefore should be instilled into the minds of children at every available opportunity. "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it," say the Scriptures. If we want a child to "go" as a Baptist, we must train him as a Baptist, both at home and in the Sunday School."—*Wayland Hoyt*.

The American Baptist Publication Society is the only benevolent institution in the English-speaking part of the world so far as we know, that publishes a Baptist Sabbath School Library. We are indebted to this Society for the main part of our Baptist literature. In the first part of this catalogue we have arranged a list of valuable books from Baptist publishers in Britain and United States to be sold for the most part at publisher's prices, we having paid the duty of 15%, and are giving 15% off to Pastors and Sunday Schools, which together is nearly equivalent to 30% reduction. It is not the object of the Society to make money, but to circulate sound literature, and any profits accruing from sales in the book-room are to be applied to gratuitous

circulation, and in aid of colportage. We strongly advise all our Sunday Schools to make a specialty of using up all the libraries in the first part of the Catalogue, but we know that some schools that have bought repeatedly, will find it necessary to select from the list in the Appendix, where will be found other than Baptist books, including the half price books of the Religious Tract Society of London. We use our best skill in selecting this stock. It is impossible for us to read all of them except at the expense of employing a *Reader*. Their general excellence is undeniable. If purchasers find any objectionable doctrines taught in any of them we would be thankful if they would return the books with criticism.

All orders for special books of any publishers not found in this Catalogue, will be promptly filled.

THE BEST WAY TO ORDER A LIBRARY.

Our plan has been eminently satisfactory to our patrons. In ordering, you will please SEND US THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:—

1. A list of books already in the Library, alphabetically arranged.
2. The average age of persons composing the classes for whom the books are required.
3. Any special books that may be desired.
4. The amount the school wishes to expend.
5. Full directions for shipping—the line of railroad and station nearest to your place, and when a long distance from a station the conveyance by which it will reach you.

POSITION, OBJECTS AND NEEDS OF THE SOCIETY.

CAPITAL.

This Society being born of the denominations' needs, derives its Capital and support from it, and all its income is for the denominations' benefit.

COLPORTAGE

Is the *great work* for which the Society exists. Its value, when wisely directed as a means of pointing men to Christ, and helping to win them from error is not likely to be overestimated. The statistics of the Baptist Churches of Sweden, United States and Prince Edward Island all bear witness that where our own literature has been spread freely through

Colportage, for a period of years there the percentage of increase in the membership is four times as great as in provinces where our Colportage is not used.

COST OF COLPORTAGE.

Experience proves that systematic Colportage is the least expensive mode of preaching the Gospel for the good accomplished. It is found desirable that each Colporteur should have the opportunity of donating \$100 worth of small books, tracts, as well as Bibles, to the needy per year. Spurgeon has 80 Colporteurs at work. He offers to send a Colporteur to any district for one year, when the friends have put into the treasury £40 or \$200 for his support. The usual estimate on this side of the water is \$250 benevolent funds for each Colporteur. There is an urgent demand for at least 25 Colporteurs to occupy the various sections of the three Provinces. We believe the Lord will give us the suitable men as soon as the means to support them is supplied. We invite every lover of Jesus and His truth to help. (1) By daily prayer for the Society and its workers. (2) By sending a donation, ever so small, or ever so large, to the Secretary, to increase our funds, in order that we may extend our Colportage, Don't wait for the agent to call. (3) By helping our Colporteurs when they come your way. (4) By recommending to your neighbors the books and papers the Society circulates.

At the last session of the Legislature an Act of Incorporation was passed which qualifies the Managers to legally receive and invest large sums or

LEGACIES.

We take the liberty to suggest the following ways in which legacies might be wisely used in the interest of our work :

(1) The interest of \$4,000, suitably invested, would support a Colporteur through all time to come.

(2) The income from \$10,000, suitably invested, would give the travelling agent a support through all time to come, and thus enable the Managers to devote every dollar collected by him directly to missionary purposes.

(3) The income from \$5,000, suitably invested, would enable the Society to sell certain books that the donor might select at half-price, and thus secure a ten-fold greater sale for that book, or to supply poor Sunday Schools with Libraries at half-price.

The following is the proper form of bequest:—"I give and bequeath to the Baptist Book and Tract Society located at Halifax, the sum of _____ dollars, to be appropriated to the Benevolent and Missionary purposes of said Society, under the direction of the Board of Managers."

MAKING A WILL.

There are scores, if not hundreds, of Baptists who, if they do not give all they ought while living, should make a will, and give at their decease. Will not the Pastors see to it, that every one whom they can influence, and to whom God has given more than they can expend while living, and more than their families will need when they are gone, shall early make a will and secure bequests for this Missionary work, that will not when they will be no longer here to give it personally.

 CONSTITUTION.

- 1st. The name of the Society shall be the Baptist Book and Tract Society.
- 2nd. The object of the Society shall be to supply the Maritime Provinces with Baptist and General Literature, through Colportage and other means.
- 3rd. That any person being a member of any Baptist Church, and contributing not less than (\$5.00) Five Dollars to the funds of the Society, shall be considered a member.
- 4th. The Society shall meet annually at the time and place of the Baptist Convention in the Maritime Provinces, when a report of the work of the preceding year shall be given, and a President, four Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, and a Board of Directors, consisting of seven members, shall be elected. The Officers shall be members of the Board. Five shall constitute a quorum. The Board shall appoint a Secretary and a Committee of Management, consisting of three of its members.
- 5th. The Society shall have a Benevolent Fund from which to supply Bibles and Religious Literature to needy families and Sunday Schools.
- 6th. The profits of the Society shall be added to the Capital or Benevolent Fund, as the Society may direct at its Annual Meeting.
- 7th. That any alteration or amendment to the foregoing may be made by a two-thirds vote, at any regular annual meeting of the Society, notice of which having been previously given.
