The Bishop has appointed Mr. Herbert T. Archbold to be Diocesan Librarian. He will have charge of the Library now kept in the Cathedral.

The Sunday Schools had this year their Christmas entertainment as usual, the infant class on one day, and the older scholars the day following. The boys of the school were entertained by the master at a "Feast," on the re-assembling of the school after the holidays.

Not to be outdone by the young people, the older members of the congregation held a very successful and pleasant social gathering on Wednesday evening, 28th January.

Some months ago we announced that Mrs. Edward Leigh had given a stall in the Cathedral, which was appropriated as that of the Canon Missioner. This has now, by Mrs. Leigh's continued liberality, been marked by its proper plate with the name of the stall, and which

also contains an inscription stating it to be the gift of Mrs. Leigh, in memory of her father, the Rev. John Rothwell, who was a clergyman of the early days of the Diocese of Toronto and afterwards of the Diocese of Ontario. He died in 1866. The stall plate is of brass with inscriptions in black enamel, and appropriate heraldic decoration enamelled in the proper colours. The engraving is the work of Messrs. Rolph Smith & Co., and the enamelling was done by Messrs. Roden Bros. The plate was designed by Mr. Chadwick.
