Oudin, a French priest, has obtaine patentior he cowng "، dietil "no prevention of sea sickness:" I distil," say eeight) of hydrochloric acid in five ounces of alcohol, and mix the product in 32 ancess of water sweetened with a litt ugar or syrup. however, prefer chloride of lime mixed with 8 ounces of water and $10 \quad 2-3$ ounces of alcohol.
