MONTREAL, May 26.—If there is one thing which more than another tends to keep alive the spirit of loyalty in Canada, it is the annual celebration of the Queen's birthday. Fortunately occurring at a period of the year when nature begins to put forth its loveliest aspect...

Amongst the fortunate corps so chosen was the Queen's Own—a corps already celebrated for its efficiency and smartness, and one which, in addition, had recently justly felt a pride. CONFECTIONERY.

Dissolve four pounds white sugar in one quart water; place this in a porcelain tinned or a slow fire for half an hour, pour into a small quantity of gelatin and allow to stand until the sugar is dissolved.

To CLEAN BRASS CANNERS.—Place the dress or goods in strong borax water, made lukewarm; let remain in soak all night, then take out and hang on line to drip, and when nearly dry press off. Do not rinse or wring.—L. E. E.

To REMOVE A BLACK CHIP HAIR.—Add to one pint cold water teaspoonful of salt and a few drops of ammonia. Wash the hair with this mixture, and when clean rinse with cold water and place in sun to dry. Do not scrub or scrub sufficiently to destroy the hair. It will look as good as new.—Ann Addie.

ANNOY ROOT FOR SICK PEOPLE.—The following I often use for my patients:—I take a dessert spoonful of arrow root and a tablespoonful of milk; wet and rub it smooth. To this I add a teaspoonful of powdered sugar. Heat a half-pint of good rich milk and bring it just up to the boil. Then, when it boils, add the arrow root and sugar. Allow it to boil three minutes, and give either warm or cold.—Hospital Agent.

To DESTROY ANTS.—Worms.—Angeworms at the root of plants can be made to come to the surface by inserting a fine hairpin or drawing-needle into the mold, and then pouring lime-water upon the soil. This will be found to be good for the health of the soil, and will keep the ants fresh and green. Apply once a week. Call lilies should be placed in a shady corner and given no water except that which falls from the clouds. Learn to use the water with a very rich earth—that is, loam and peat mixed. You will give it too much water, and they are wanted to bloom.—Ann Addie.

ALMOND MACAROONS.—Pour boiling water on half a pound almonds, take skins off and throw cold water over them. Soak in cold water for a smooth paste, add one pound of pulverized sugar and whites of three eggs, and beat the paste well together with back of spoon; dip the hands in water and roll mixture into balls the size of a nutmeg, and lay on buttered paper on a baking sheet. When done, dip the hands in water and pass through the macaroons, making the surface smooth. Bake in a moderate oven for three-quarters of an hour. If this recipe is strictly followed, the macaroons will be perfect, as made by professional confectioners.

BUCKETT BUTTER SCOTCH.—Three pounds "coffee A" sugar, four pound butter, half teaspoon cream tartar, and one-half teaspoon salt. Melt the sugar and cold water as will dissolve the sugar; boil without stirring till it will easily break. Add the butter and cream tartar, and when done, add the lemon; have a dripping pan well buttered and pour in one-fourth inch thick, and when done, dip the hands in water and pass through the macaroons, making the surface smooth. Bake in a moderate oven for three-quarters of an hour. If this recipe is strictly followed, the macaroons will be perfect, as made by professional confectioners.

It is very easy to make, but will need some practice.

The needle must be first brought up through the work at the exact spot where the knot is to be; then the thread is taken by the left hand, and held midway between the work and the needle, and the right hand twists the needle through the loop down to the point of the needle, and passes the thread under the needle again.

This is done, and the needle is brought up through the loop with the left hand, while the right hand draws the thread through the loop, and the needle is held properly, after the thread is twisted round the needle. These knots are most effective for the center of the work at the center of the design.

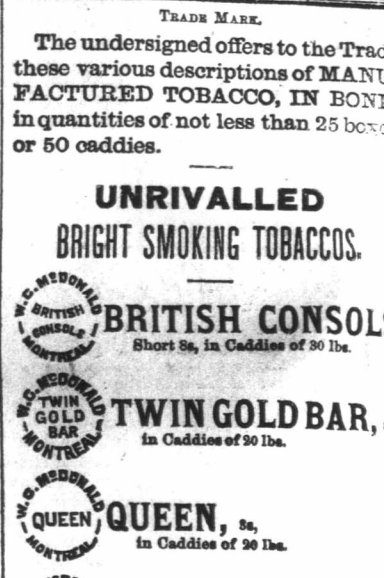
