AMOTHER ARRORY DISCOVERED.

To day the police discovered another extensive manufactory of ammunition in a small house in South Earl street. All the materials for the manufacture of Minie rifle cartridges were present in abundance—conneal bullet moulds, powder measures, small tundishes, shapes, and paper cut in the requisite pattern. In two boxes the officers found no less than 1,200 cartridges, the greater number of which were fully prepared for Minie rifles. The police have ascertained that over £600 a week has been paid to persons working in those ammunition factories in this city; four have been discovered, but it is believed there are many more, and that vast quantities of ammunition have been distributed through the city and country generally.
