New York, Jan. 21.-At the annual meeting of the National Association of Amateur Oarsmen to-night, a rowing was selected unanimously as the place for holding the regatta on July 28 and 29 next.

A communication from the secretary of the Henley, England, Association was read, stating that the reports that the Americans were not wanted in the Henley Regatta were false, and inviting the entry of all American amateurs.

George W. Van Vleet of the Pennsylvania Barge Club of Philadelphia was disqualified for selling places. The committee decided to reinstate Edwin Hedley of the Vesper Boat Club of Philadelphia, but not until August 10 next.

Garfield of Albany, that the regatta rules be amended so that each boat in the regatta should be excluded from the senior single-scull race, and that the winner of this race be entitled to meet the champion for the championship prize, and in offering this resolution Mr. Garfield explained that the present rules of the regatta were such that the winner of the regatta would be the same as in former years, while the possible absence of the race for the championship single.
