The Quarterly Meetings of this Committee shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, 8th August, and Thursday, 7th November, 1872 ; and on Thursday, 13th February, and Thursday, 8th May, 1873. The members of the Committee are requested to give the Secretary early notice of their intention to be present at the Sessions, that provision may be made for their entertainment among the friends.

The attention of Missionaries is requested to the following Resolution of the Committee, passed in August, 1872 :—That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the missions ; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done ; and in order to do this, missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previous to the meeting of the Committee ; and in case any of the missionaries should fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent, until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hope that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the good of the mission work.

## REPORT.

### ADDRESS OF THE GENERAL MISSIONARY COMMITTEE.

*To the Friends, Collectors, and Ministers,*

*Of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada :*

DEAR FELLOW-LABOURERS :—At the close of another year, we are permitted to address you in language of thankfulness and congratulation. The twelve months we now review have been marked by many trials, and by measureless mercies. As a nation, God has signally blessed us in Canada : there is now a degree of prosperity in our Dominion, which has probably never been surpassed in our annals. The resources of our vast territories are being opened up ; a tide of emigration is pouring in upon our shores ; trade is healthy ; and in other countries Canada is attracting a larger share of the attention of statesmen and capitalists, than it has ever done before in a time of peace. We accept these signs of national vigor and prosperity, not only as an indication of the grand and widening future which is before us as a nation, but as an additional reason why we who are striving to lay the foundations of that future in the fear of God, and in the principles of Christianity, should increase our diligence, should extend our labours, should renew our covenant, and consecrate ourselves afresh to the holy work in which we are engaged. Nations owe more to their Christian labourers, than to their astutest statesmen. The men whose earnest prayers, holy examples, and self-denying faith, leaven society with the principles of purity, of justice, and of piety, do more to strengthen the state, and to build up the bulwarks of the land, than the political leaders, whose work is merely to give legislative enforcement to the public sentiments which have been created by other forces : in making the world what God would have it to be, the churches lead, and do not follow, the secular governments of the age.

We thank you most heartily for the earnest and cheerful co-operation which the committee has received at your hands during

tha last year. As Ministers in charge of Mission Stations, you have been called to toil, and anxiety, and care. Nevertheless, you have found a holy joy in your work, and under the inspiration of love to Christ, the sense of duty has been lost in the consciousness of privilege in being permitted to influence immortal minds, and mould them for the future service and fellowship of God. As Collectors, you have travelled painful journeys ; have endured some chilling receptions ; have denied yourselves of many social comforts, that you may help onward the conquest of this world for Christ. We congratulate you on these toils : we are glad for your sakes they have been endured. The ennobling of your own nature, and the calm, hallowed satisfaction which the memory of such services brings to the heart, has been to you a rich reward.

As Contributors, some of you have given freely ; given as the committee believes what has, in some instances, been the offering of a self-denying love and faith. Others perhaps will feel, on reviewing the past, that their gifts have never reached this point : that they have never really sacrificed a personal comfort or indulgence, to help on the work of God. We commend this matter to your conscience : it is for you and Jesus to decide. In the light of His cross ; in presence of His agony ; under the shining of His love for you, we venture to ask, " How much oweest thou my Lord ? "

The Superintendents, and Teachers, and Scholars of our Sabbath Schools will accept the assurance of the Committee's appreciation of their services. It is surely well that our young people, even our little children, should be taught that it is a noble thing to work and give for the salvation of souls, and the enthronement of Christ in the heart of the world. Will our ministers and teachers impress upon the young that missionary labour is labour for Christ : not merely for a church fund ; not merely for the good of men, but for Christ. Lift up the children's thoughts and aspirations to Him. And will they also tell the juveniles that the committee recognise and thank them for their services.

#### RESULTS.

We have realized a year's prosperity. The total contributions from our work in Canada amount to \$8,079 97, being \$810 62 in advance of last year. Our membership in the Dominion is now six thousand seven hundred and ten, being an increase for the year of

two hundred and seventeen. Our church property is now valued at about two hundred and twenty-three thousand dollars, having increased twenty-two thousand one hundred and thirty-five dollars for the year. Sixty-four of our members have passed away by death, and are, we believe, now singing higher hymns, and joining in loftier worship, before the throne of God. Our number of missionaries in Canada is forty-six, and they are toiling, amidst many difficulties, to build up the walls of our Zion. The English Committee continues to help us, both in men and money. During the year, Bros. G. J. Reeve, J. Ferguson, G. Clarke, and J. Dyke have reached us here, and have entered upon their labour amidst the welcomes of our people, and encouraging prospects of success. The committee trust that abundant blessings will rest upon these brethren, in their new sphere of holy work. The Home Committee have also granted us \$1,946 66 in money, to help us in our work; and, as stated above, our own Circuits and Missions have contributed \$8,079 97: making a total of money at the disposal of the Committee of \$10,026 63. The expenditure for the year is \$10,741 20, so that the outgo has overrun the income by \$714 57. There is no doubt the expenditure will be more the coming year, than the past. We therefore kindly, but earnestly appeal to those who love the Lord's work, to make the income exceed the disbursements; and remembering the answer to the appeal of last year, we have confidence in again asking increased help from those whom God has largely blessed, and who have come to our help before.

The Committee desires you to remember that God has signally and abundantly blessed us as a people. Though young, compared with many of the sister churches, by whose side we labour, yet we are cheered by their kindest sympathies. We reciprocate their confidence and affection. We desire our people everywhere to cultivate the truest love for all who love our Lord Jesus Christ, and to pray unceasingly for the whole church of God.

The Parent Society has reaped abundant blessings during the last year. The financial position is thus epitomised by the Secretary:—

The amount realized at the Metropolitan Anniversary in 1871 was £256 15s. 4d. Received by the Treasurer and Secretary, apart from the district returns, £888 2s. 4d. Repayments by Trustees of Mission Chapels, £575.

Grants from the Book-Room, £550. Collected on Home Missions, £1,433 0s. 10d. Collected on Australasian Stations, as far as reported, £587 0s. 8d. Collected in Canada, and expended on Missions there, £1,490 5s. 6d. Collected on Home Circuits, £21,043 19s. 9d. Total, £26,824 5s. 5d. This sum is exclusive of £3,063 3s. 3d. raised on the Home Missions towards the support of the Missionaries; and £2,371 2s. for the building of chapels and schools. Add these sums together, and they make £32,258 10s. 8d. contributed for the support and enlargement of our Missionary operations at Home and Abroad.

The field is wide on which our Missionaries are now working :—

Australasia is an immense region, comprising Australia, Tasmania, New Zealand, etc. Australia itself is a continent of vast extent, much of which is still a *terra incognita*. Australia is divided into different Colonies, under separate governments. Queensland alone is more than three times as large as the empire of France was. These vast and flourishing colonies will soon be great nations. England sent many of her worst sons to Australia: should she not send some of her best? If she sent the purifying members of society, should she not send healing? But besides the immigrants, there is a large, but decreasing aboriginal population. The number of black people, whose habits are nomadic, and whose characters are utterly debased, is not less than 20,000 in Queensland alone.

And on this vast continent, Primitive Methodism is doing a noble work :—

The Australasian Stations are divided into four Districts, and many of them are independent Circuits. But we still have 8 Missions in Adelaide District, 11 in Melbourne District, 18 in Sydney District, and 6 in New Zealand. Forty-seven Missionaries are employed by the Society on those antipodal Missions.

Africa is still calling forth earnest effort, and noble daring, from our ministers and people. At present, only three of our European ministers are there, but they are assisted by native teachers, and other brethren will soon sail from England to their help :—

Brothers Burnett and Rowe have been obliged to return to England, to recuperate their exhausted energies; but the Rev. W. Holland has gone out to supply their "lack of service" at Fernando Po. The details of success in Western Africa continue to possess a thrilling interest; and tens of thousands will listen with delight to the statements which the returned Missionaries will have to make. Brother Buckenham is still labouring alone at Aliwal north. The liberality of his white congregation has been extraordinary; but his labours are too arduous to be long sustained. He needs a colleague, who could take work among the settlers, and leave him at liberty to labour exclusively among the colored people, whose language he has now acquired. Mr. Maylott's health fails seriously; but with the heroism of a real Missionary, he expresses himself resolved to endure or die. The doctors, who have seen him, have ordered him to Europe; but he says, "No, it must be Africa or Heaven. And if my Heavenly Father should call me hence to heaven, my last faltering accent shall be, 'Lord, save Africa: let her toilers die; but let Africa live!'" He says he is happy: never was happier. He is resting on the atonement of love. May Heaven prolong his precious life, and that of his devoted wife!

And yet there is not, in our wide field, a more important part than Canada. Our territories stretch from the Atlantic to the Pacific: from the St. Lawrence to the Polar Sea. The lands we hold, which are capable of cultivation, are not less than one million two hundred and fifty thousand square miles, and would supply sustenance for a population of two hundred and fifty millions of people. The whole of this nation must be won for God. The noble political freedom we enjoy, must be hallowed by the spirit of spiritual reverence and moral dignity which make freedom a richer heritage.

Looking, then, at the grandeur of our work; weighing well the measure of temporal prosperity with which our Heavenly Father is blessing us as a people; measuring our obligation by the love Christ has borne to us, and to our race; and making our contributions a matter of system, of principle, and of conscience, may we not hope to find our income in Canada reaching ten thousand dollars for the next year? Will each Station try? Shall we resolve to give ourselves and our substance more fully to Christ? The Committee place this great question in your hands.

## RECOMMENDATIONS.

---

The following Recommendations, touching our different Connexional Funds, were presented to the consideration of last Conference for adoption :—

1. That though there is a balance in favor of the Children's Fund of \$63 08, we would not recommend any reduction of the assessment, in consequence of the number of children to be provided for next year.
2. That the request of Brother Lomas, to allow his two eldest children to draw from the Children's Fund the amount to which they are entitled, in consequence of not being allowed anything for some time after the eldest was two years old, be granted.
3. That we suggest the appointment of a Committee, to be composed of Brothers Robert Walker, Daniel McLean, Revs. W. Rowe, W. Bee, and H. Harris, to decide in the matter of the Book Room, as to whether the increased accommodation offered shall be taken in connection with the present Book Room, or another place taken sufficiently large to continue the business as at present. Also, that the case of the Assistant, now employed in the Book Room, be decided by said Committee.
4. That, for the future, all moneys raised for Missionary purposes shall be exclusively employed for that purpose; and no person be allowed to draw from that fund for the benefit of any other fund.


