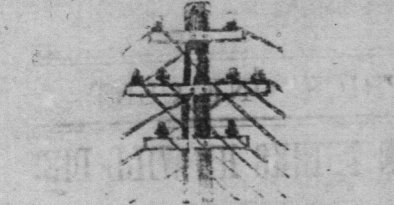

European Anarchists in America.

Unusually lies the head that wears a crown," so wrote Shakespeare a few centuries ago, and the saying seems to have been more force than it had then.

Next after that came the outbreak of 1848, which quickly ended in smoke, and led up to Louis Napoleon's mischievous coup d'etat of December 2, and left the rule of the sword stronger than before.

Count Kalnoky points out that this outbreak of terrorism began immediately after the publication in the seditious papers of Vienna of the proceedings of the socialist congress, which was held at Pittsburgh last November, which was controlled and directed by John Most, and which distinctly advocated assassination and the destruction of public and private property to avenge the so-called wrongs of the people; and that among the papers found in the possession of the anarchists Kennel, Schultz, Fossak, and Lissa, lately expelled from Switzerland, were letters and instructions from Most; that the money stolen from Herr Finkert had been forwarded to Most, and that Finkert, the socialist editor of the recently suppressed paper Zukunft (the Future), was about to sail from London to join Most in New York.

It is well known that Chicago and other cities, having a large foreign-born population are slumbering volcanoes that may break out any day. The anarchists find that they can do openly in America what they dare hardly attempt in the most secret manner in Europe; and New York is made the headquarters of their central committee.

Republic is little esteemed by them; except for the opportunity it affords for conspiracy and agitation un molested. Political freedom, as we understand it, is not what these men want. They have no more liking for constitutional government than a tiger would have for a feed of hay and oats.

Mr. Blake and the Catholics. That Mr. Blake will do anything so daring as to suddenly make terms with the Quebec blues is more than improbable; but that before long we shall see a practical, though not ostensible, alliance between the reform leader and the great majority of the Catholics of the Dominion is about as certain as anything political can be.

Mr. Costigan's ministerial days are numbered, and neither Senator Smith nor Senator O'Donoghue has the capacity or the influence to stem the movement.

Mr. Blake's anti-orange speech will be translated into French, and will have a powerful effect upon the French Canadian mind. An Irish Catholic dislikes orangeism for reasons that are at least intelligible, and is therefore often able to discriminate between the individual and the system.
