## CUARENT TRADE COHDITIONS.

 ONTARIO.A strong' feeling of confidence pervades the lumber trade of Ontario. Manufacturers and dealers, almost without an exception, report nunuerous enquiries for stock, while considerable of the season's production of lumber has already been contracted for. In pine the noost active dẹmand pertaiains to thie lower grades, the supply of which has become very meagre. Unless the approaching season should be much less active than is anticipated, no great depreciation in prices is libely to accur. In the Ottana valley good pine shorts have advanced recently about onè döllar per thōusand Sbipping cults have been matked up about tivo dollars per thoussnd. Hardwond prices have not changed from our last quotations, bat it is quite cerrain that the production of hardwoods this year will be heavy, and it is too much to expect that the prices now ruling will hold throughout the season. However, manufacturers-are adhering firmly to prices, and this in itself will have a tendency to spastäin the strength of the märket.
qubbbe and nevi brunswick.
Ih the city of Quebec there has developed a ssarcity of dry lumber, and contractors are finding some difficulty in carfying on buiding operations. Retall dealers have very little stocle for sale, and this they are holding for higher prices. Dimension deals of ordinary lengths are selling at $\$ 11.50$ per thousand feet. In the Maritime Provinces building operations are not as far aulvanced as in Quebec, but nevertheless manufacturers and dealers report a satisfactory demand for lumber. Shippers have putchased very heavily for export. The shingle manufactureres and dealers are watching with much interest the outcome of the meeting which is being held to-day to complete the organization of a manufacturers' association for Quebec, New Brunswick and Mance, to which further reference will be madelnext week

Some slight alterations were made last week in the wholesale price list of lumber for the Minneapolis market. No. 4 fenc ing, 4 -inch, 6,8 and 10 feet, was reduced $\$ 1 ; A$ and $B$ siding, all, lengths, 50 cents; meh selects, 50 cents ; and dimension and umbers, 23 feet and longer, $\$ 1$. Yellow pine prices have also undergone a readjustment, the new list showing a reduction of from one to two dollars per thousand on all itzirs, except heavy joist and timbers: Triese changes represent the chief features of the lumber market of the past week. Trade is not moving very-lively, as spring building hias been backward on account of uniavorable weather conditions. The market for white pine has exhibited a slight weakness in certain lines, especially piece stuff. Eastern wholesalers have, large stocks on hand, and unless an active demand from the east shall develop, their purchases for some time to come wall be very moderate. At Saginaw Canadian pine, log run, is worth $\$ 16$ to $\$ 18$, box lumber $\$ 12.50$ to $\$ \$_{4}$, Norway $\$ 14$ to $\$ 14.50$, and mill culls \$i2. Spruce prices have been maintain. cd. and owing to the high price of logs, lower values are not anticipated. Hard. wood stocks zre stlll scarce. There is an excellent call for common and first and second plain red and white oak. White ash mod basswood are firm, but in respeet to maple there seems to be a feling that that lumber may suffer trom overproducticn.

## soretins.

The unsatisfactory state of the building zrade in Great Bitain is causing holders
of timber some uneasiness. Buyers hesi tate to purchase in advance of require ments, and if this condition prevails for some time it is feared that a brcal in prices may result. Some encouragement, however, is found in the fact that prices of Canadian lumber have not only main tained their strength, but that in a few in. stances advances have been made. Comparrd with one month ago, square pine is about one shilling per cubic foot higher at Glasgow. First quality Quebec pine deals are about six shillings per standard higher, third quality broad about seven shillings higher, while therc has been an average advance on fourth quality of about seven shillings per standard. Quehec pine, 2 -inch sidings, have sdvanced 10 shillings and $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch six $s$ sillings. In the London market wancy fine has appreciated in price, as has riso elm, which is in very scant si"upty. At Liverpool first quality pine di als, sxe, selling at $f, 20$ to $\mathcal{2} 24$ per standard, second quality at $£ 16$ ros. to $\mathscr{f} 17$ 10s., and third quality at $\mathscr{E} 10$ to $£ 10$ 10s. New Brunswick spruce is worth from $£ 7$ I5s. to $£ 8$ per standard. British shippers are reported to have sold a considerable quantity of stock for export to South Africa.
