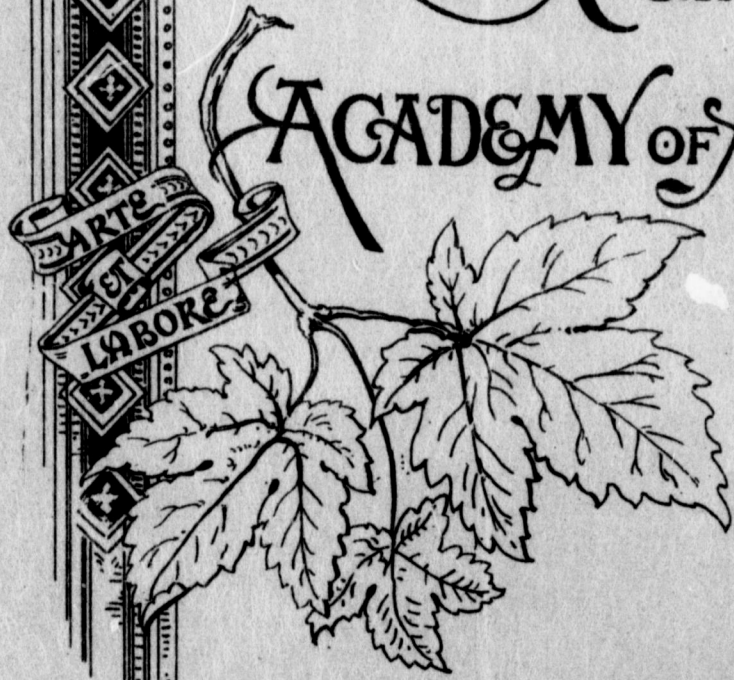

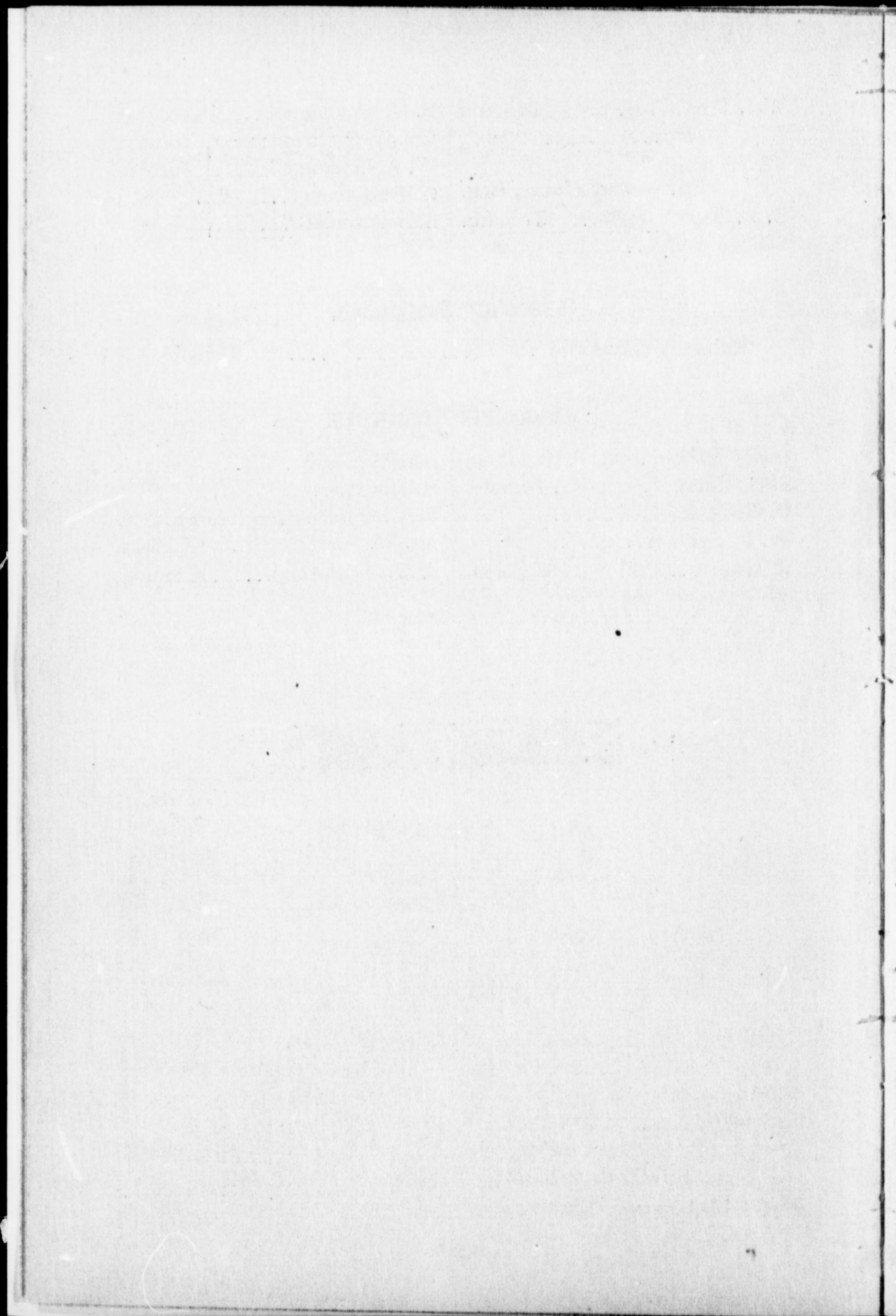

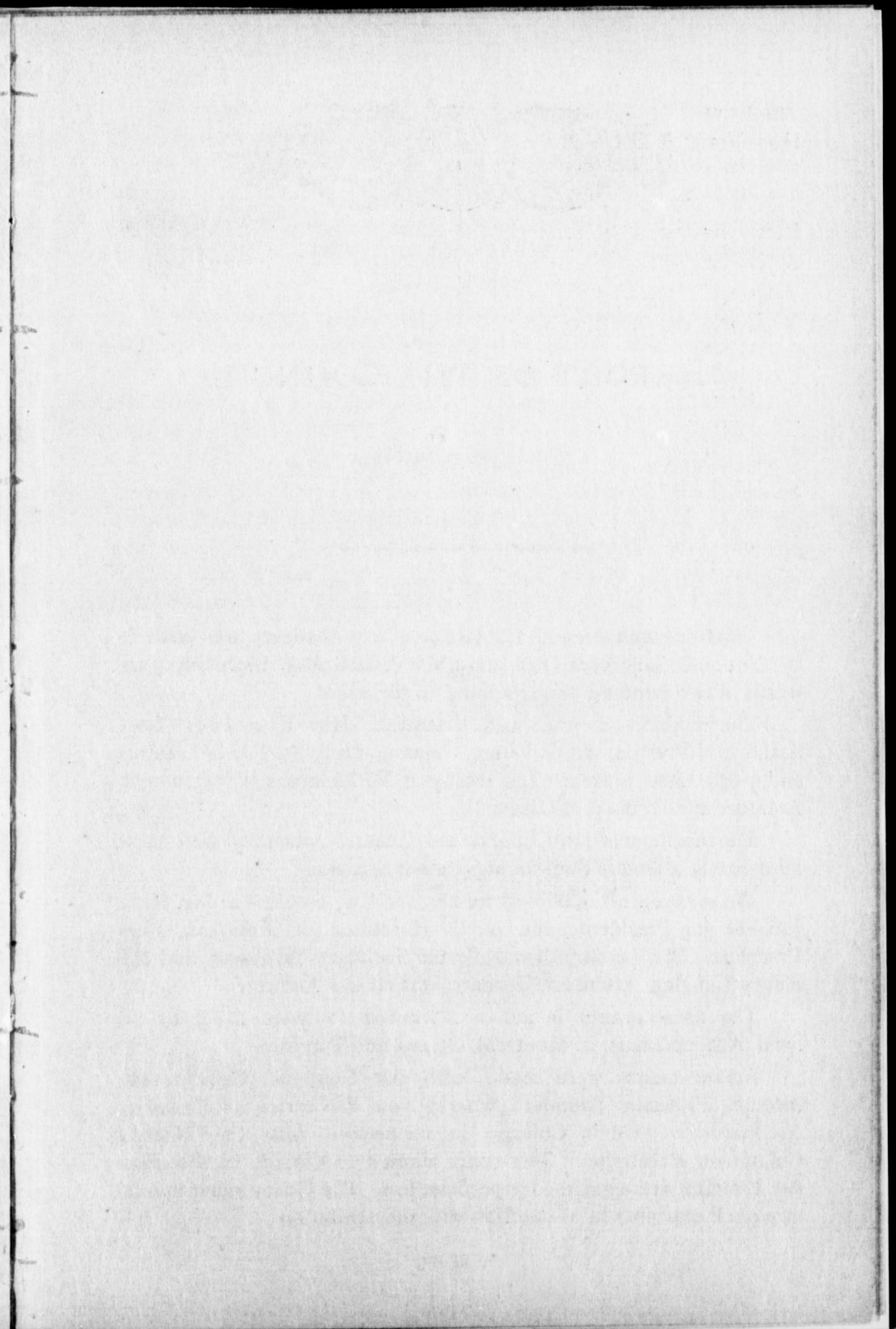

## REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

FOR THE YEAR 1892.

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The thirteenth Annual Exhibition of the Academy was held in the National Gallery, at Ottawa, in March last year, there were upwards of two hundred pictures hung on the walls.

The Exhibition was well attended. His Excellency Lord Stanley, of Preston, the Governor-General, Lady Stanley of Preston, and party were present ; also many of the Members of Parliament, Senators and Citizens of Ottawa.

The meetings of the Council and General Assembly were more numerous attended than on any former occasion.

The election of the officers for 1892 and '93 resulted in Mr. O. R. Jacobi being President ; Mr. A. C. Hutchison, of Montreal, Vice-President. Mr. Jas Smith was elected Secretary-Treasurer, and Mr. Henry Langley, Architect, Toronto, was chosen Auditor.

The usual grants in aid of Advanced Art were made to the local Academicians, in Montreal, Ottawa and Toronto.

Arrangements were made with the Dominion Government, through Professor Saunders, whereby an Exhibition of Canadian Art would be held in Chicago in connection with the World's Columbian Exhibition. The space allotted to Canada in the Fine Art Building averaged 3000 superficial feet. The Government agreed to pay all expenses in connection with the exhibition.



The best examples of Canadian Art were to be collected for this Exhibition, and in order to get the best possible pictures by Canadian Artists an Exhibition was decided to be held in Montreal to open March 1893, from which a selection would be made by the Committee of Artists representing the R. C. A., the Ontario Society of Artists, Toronto, the Art Associations of Ottawa and Montreal.

There were no Associates elected last year.

The annual conversazione of members and honorary members will be held in the Gallery on the evening of Feb. 28th, at 8 o'clock.

An election of one Academician Painter and one Academician Architect will be held at the General Assembly on the 1st of March next at 2 p. m.

We have to mourn the death of two members during the past year, viz : Mr. Wm. Storm, a prominent architect of Toronto and a warm friend of the Academy ; also Paul Peel, a young and very promising painter, and one who bid fair to take a high place in Artistic circles, and whose work will be much missed in our annual exhibitions.

The accounts for the past year are submitted showing the receipts and expenditure and balance on hand.
