


5th. Clothing. Always keep the feet warm and the head cool. Wear flannel, merino or silk next to the skin. All garments should be worn loose and easy.

#### Cookery for the Sick

When one is sick, the stomach cannot always contain certain foods, and it is generally necessary to find something appetizing, and at the same time nourishing, so as to build up the bodily strength without impairing the digestive organs.

#### Below we give you some Recipes

To Make Beef Tea.—Cut a pound of lean beef into small pieces; without any water put it into a jar, cover tightly and set in a pot of cold water. Heat gradually to a boil, and continue this steadily for three or four hours until the meat is like white rags and the juice is all drawn out; season with salt to the taste, and when cold, skim off the fat. Serve with crackers or toast.

For Boiling Eggs.—Put the eggs in a saucepan of boiling water, and let them stand where they will be kept hot, but the water will not boil for ten minutes. This gives an evenly cooked, but soft-boiled egg, and the process simply has to be lengthened or shortened to produce a harder or softer degree.

f

Rice Water For Invalids.—Three tablespoons rice, one quart cold water, pinch of salt; wash rice, add cold water, cook slowly until rice is tender; it may be flavored with lemon.

Chicken Broth.—Clean half a chicken and remove the skin. Pour on it a quart of cold water and salt to taste. Add a teaspoonful of rice and boil slowly for two or three hours. Then skim it well to get off all the fat and add a little parsley. This is one of the most agreeable of dishes for many sick people.

Oatmeal Gruel.—Boil a pint of water, and while boiling mix with it two tablespoonsful of oatmeal, which has been first rubbed smooth in a little cold water; also add half a pint of milk and a little salt. Let all simmer together for half an hour, then strain through a sieve, sweeten, and add a little nutmeg.

Milk Punch has often maintained the life of very sick persons when it has been impossible for anything else for several days. Use sweet milk, 1 glass; powdered sugar, 2 tablespoonfuls; brandy, 2 tablespoonfuls, ice. Dissolve sugar in the milk, add brandy and ice, stirring well.


