Committee-Chamber, Bishop's Palace, Quebec, 6th. November 1790.

SIR,

I S Excellency LORD DORCHESTER, with the advice of the Council, was pleased, by his Order in Council of the 22d. of July 1788, to order, " That the Clerk of the Courts of Justice should on or before the 1st. day of October then next, file in the Council-Office " an Eſtreat or Account of all Fines, Forfeitures and other dues, Articles of the Casual " Revenues of the Crown, at any time within ten years then last past incurred in either of their " respective Courts. That all Magistrates, Justices of the Peace and others ſhould make a like Eſtreat of all ſuch Dues as had accrued by any proceſs before them in Sessions or otherwise. That like Eſtreats ſhould be made by all Sheriffs, Clerks and other Officers of the Courts of Justice of every kind, of all and every ſums of money that had at any time come to their hands, as part of the Royal Revenue. And to the end that it might be known by the report of the ſeveral persons officiating as Notaries Public what ſums had accrued since they had reſpectively been in Office, for quinns, lods et ventes or other the Seigneurial Rights of the Crown, the ſaid Notaries are commanded to make due Report thereof to the Council-Office within the time aforementioned."

And further to Order, " That every the ſaid reſpective Officers, Magistrates, Clerks of Court, Sheriffs, Coroners and others having any Public Monies in their hands, ſhould forthwith pay over the ſame to His Ma- jesty's Receiver-General for the uſe of the Crown, and that they ſhould continue to do ſo in all times coming as often as they might receive any part of the Royal Revenue in the course of the execution of their truſts.

" And that the like Eſtreats, Returns, Accounts and Reports, ſhould be filed in the ſaid Council Office half-yearly, from and after the ſaid first day of October, by every of the Officers aforesaid, under his signature and upon oath, and that a certified copy thereof be at the ſame time filed in the Office of His Majesty's Re- ceiver-General."

His Lordship's Order aforesaid was published in the Quebec Gazetteſ of the 31ſt. July 1788 N° 1198, and 7th. and 14th. of August following N° 1199 and 1200.

On the 17th. of May laſt His Lordship, with the advice of the Council, was pleased to commit to a Committee of His Majesty's Council, of which I am Chairman, " to make inquiry how far the ſaid Order of the 22d. of July 1788 has been complied with by the diſterent Officers as well as Notaries Public, thereby required to furniſh Eſtreats and Reports of the ſums accrued to His Majesty in their reſpective Departments, calling upon ſuch as may be in default for a Juſtification of their conduet, and reporting the Reſult."

In Order to enable the Committee to Report to His Lordship upon this Reference, I am directed by them to call upon You for the Reaſon why the ſaid Order has not been complied with on your part, and I request your anſwer addressed to JENKIN WILLIAMS, Esquire, Clerk of the Council with all poſſible diſpatch.
