An Act to amend the Act respecting the Game Laws of Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend chapter sixty-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting Game Laws of Upper Canada." Preamble.

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The fifth section of the said recited Act shall be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following shall be substituted for the said repealed section;— New provision instead of sec. 5.

"No wild swan, goose, or duck of the kinds known as the Mallard, Grey Duck, Black Duck, Wood Duck, or any of the kinds of Duck known as Teal, shall be hunted, taken or killed between the Twentieth day of April and the First day of September in any year; nor shall any Musk-rat be trapped between the Twentieth day of April and the Thirty-first day of December in any year." Water fowl not be killed at certain seasons.
