THE ULTIMATUM SENT TO VENEZUELA FINAL

Attitude of the United States Discussed by English Newspapers—The Monroe Doctrine—A French Journalist's Opinion.

London, Oct. 21.—In view of the many reports in circulation regarding the attitude of Great Britain towards Venezuela, the following official announcement was made today: "In consequence of Venezuela not offering an apology or reparation for the Cuban incident, the Marquis of Salisbury has taken the view that her what reparation Great Britain requires. But, as the relations between the two countries have been broken for some years, communication was not sent through any diplomatic channel. As the document has not reached the destination, it is not considered desirable to give the details of its contents. But it is considered in forcible terms and in definite language that Great Britain will not permit Venezuela to treat the boundaries marked by the course of the rivers Orinoco and Amazon, but it will insist that the question of the other boundaries to territory be submitted to arbitration."

The dispute between Great Britain and Venezuela which resulted in the former sending an ultimatum to the latter, is attracting more and more attention and is much commented upon today in the English press. The following quotations give some idea of the attitude of the English newspapers. The Westminster Gazette remarks: "After a tremendous fuss the Nicaragua incident turned out to be a ridiculous small beer affair. In a short time we were back to the normal state of affairs.
