SAN JOSE
THREATENS TO. WIPE OUT ORCHARDS IN LAMBTON COUNTY

In the Southerly Portion of the County, especially, unless Prompt Action is taken to control this pest, whole areas of orchards will be devastated.

The Insect has obtained a strong foothold in the townships of Sombra, Dawn and Euphemia, is common in Moore, Enniskillen and Brooke, and has been discovered in isolated cases in the four northerly townships.

San Jose Scale attacks all fruit trees except the Sour Cherry. . Small trees may be killed in a couple of years; larger trees usually take longer, but ultimately will perish if not treated.

Examine your trees carefully, and if you find on the twigs and branches round, tiny, black specks, which under a lens show a little nipple in the centre, surrounded by a depressed ring or groove, you can be certain it is San Jose Scale. One of these little black specks may mean a million next fall.

San Jose Scale can be controlled, as we have proven in our Demonstration Orchards at Florence, Rutherford and Port Lambton.

Steps necessary in the control of this insect are :--

1. Thorough pruning to thin out unnecessary branches and to remove dead and dying limbs.
2. Removing the rough bark from the large branches and trunks of the trees with a hoe.
3. Thorough spraying with Lime Sulphur of a specific gravity of 1.035 , before the buds burst.
Once the Scale is brought under control it is not difficult to keep it there and doess not require speoial treatment
ed by all good orchardists to insure clean truit.
