GREAT STRIKE OF ANTHRACITE COAL MINERS HAS NOW BEGUN

Over One Hundred Thousand Men Are Said to Be Idle and President Mitchell Says Fifteen Thousand More Will Quit Work

To-Day—Some Collieries Yet Working.

Philadelphia, Sept. 17.—The strike of miners in the anthracite coal fields of Pennsylvania, which represents practically the hard coal output of the world, began to-day. According to President Mitchell of the United Mine Workers of America, who is personally directing the strike from his headquarters at Hazleton, the success of the four-day effort to stop up the mines exceeded the expectations of the strike leaders.

The Hard Coal Region. The hard coal region is divided into four great districts, the Lackawanna, Wyoming, Lehigh and Schuylkill regions. In the first two, representing nearly 90,000 men, the strike is practically complete, only one mine, employing a few hundred men, being operated, and this, the strikers say, they hope to close soon.

Strike May Extend. Indications tonight, however, point to the closing of the entire anthracite region. The district that operated to-day despite the strike was not general among the upward of 200 collieries which comprise the region.

Men Are Organizing. Nearly all the efforts of the strike leaders are being directed to organizing the men in the weak Schuylkill and Lehigh regions and to get their organizers and orators reestablishing their work.

No Violence Yet. No violence or rioting has been reported in the first day of the strike. No progress has yet been made in the efforts of some of the operators to bring about a settlement of the trouble through arbitration.

70,000 MEN ARE IDLE In District No. 1 Covering the Lackawanna and Wyoming Valleys—The Up Complete.

Schenectady, Pa., Sept. 17.—Pennsylvania's anthracite coal mines are now practically under way. This morning found the thousands of mine workers in the Lackawanna and Wyoming valleys ready for the struggle with the operators, and when the scores of breaker whistles sounded at five o'clock to-day, the strike was complete at any one place to warrant a report.

Dicker Was Enthusiastic. Fred Dicker, the member of the National Executive Board in charge of District No. 1, covering the Lackawanna and Wyoming valleys, was enthusiastic over the strike news which came from the local unions and all reported a complete stoppage.

Other Employers Out. The carpenters, car repairers, blacksmiths and helpers at every Delaware, Lackawanna and Wyoming Valley colliery joined the strikers to-day. They were asked to take care of the coal and to handle it in the breakers. They refused to quit at any mine.

Operators Send for Miners. Operators from the mines in the Lackawanna and Wyoming valleys are sending for the miners to return to work. The operators are not looking for a compromise, but they are sending for the miners to return to work.

Striking Miners Meet. The striking miners held a large and enthusiastic meeting at Hazleton, Pa., to-day. The miners are determined to hold out until their demands are met.

No Mining in Wyoming Valley. At 11 o'clock it was given out at strikers' headquarters in Hazleton, Pa., that no mining is to be done in the Wyoming Valley until the operators agree to the miners' demands.
