speech that reached a great height of parliamentary eloquence, a speech that will mark the beginning of a new epoch Borden proclaimed that the capacity of voluntaryism had een exhausted and that compulsory military service would now be resorted to to maintain undiminished the ranks of Canada's army at the front and the power of bur istriking force in the war. Fifty thousand men will be needed per-
haps one hundred thousand and the machinery to get them will be introduced with expedition and despatch. The scene in the chamber when the Prime Minlister made
the announcement will be long remembered. Crowded Conservative benches broke into a frenzy of cheering, members leaped to their feet, waved handkerchiefs or pounded their
