An Act to amend an Act intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act and Ordinance therein mentioned. relating to the Trinity House of Montreal and to amend and consolidate the provisions thereof," and to make further provisions concerning Pilots.

THEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act herein below referred Preamble. to, and to make provision respecting Pilots : Therefore Her Majesty. &c., enacts as follows :

I. Of the nine Wardens mentioned in the third section of the Act 12 One Warden 5 Vic., cap. 117, one shall always be a licensed Pilot, having practised as an p 117, to such for at least ten years, and appointed in the manner by the said Act be a Pilot. prescribed.
