We have the pleasure of handing you here with our Weekly Prices Current, showing the condition of our market for the past week. Our quotations, it should be understood, represent the wholesale prices generally. In the making up of small orders, higher prices have to be charged. All quotations are duty paid, unless otherwise stated.

Commercial Report.

BREADSTUFFS.—Flour has arrived in moderate quantities the past week, principally from New York, as prices still keep too high in the Canadian markets to admit of importations from thence. Prices remain as last quoted, with a little more firmness on the part of holders, owing to an advance in New York of 50c., which however has partly been met by the advance in gold. We quote extra State, \$7 to \$7.25, for low and medium grades, \$7.60 to \$7.75 for choice. Canadian is selling at \$7.25 to \$7.75: very little, however, is bringing the latter rate, and that only in retail lots of very favorite brands.

Corn meal in moderate demand, at \$4.50. **SUGAR AND MOLASSES.**—These articles are firmly held, as prices have advanced in the West Indies. Molasses of the better qualities, at present rates abroad, cannot be laid down here at our quotations, and holders are reckoning on an advance in rates here.

FREIGHTS.—Our freight market this week is not so firm. Shippers are well supplied for the time, and should any vessels be forced on the market, rates would doubtless give way. Same time tonnage is not plenty, and the presumption is there will be little change in rates for the present. The following detail charters are reported: *Juno*, 955, *Perseverance*, 1150, *Nautilus*, 1200—all for Liverpool, at 75s. 6d.; *Annie Maine*, 490, and *Agra*, 640, same voyage, on private terms; *Mary Anna*, 500, London, 82s.; *John Clark*, 1073, Bristol, Newport or Cardiff, 73s. 9d.; *Softid*, 378, and *Farsund*, both for Bristol Channel, 75s.; *King Eystien*, London, 82s.; *Cheviot*, 214, 80s., and *August*, 217, 77s. 6d., both for Newry; *Mohawk*, Cork Quay, 75s.; new bark, 500 tons, Dublin, 77s. 6d.; *Jane Young*, 450, Belfast, 74s.; *Signal*, 312, Dundalk, 86s.; *Levanter*, 551, Warren Point, 74s., birch 27s. 6d.; *Lalla Rookh*, 494, Dublin, 77s. 6d., or Belfast or Warren Point, at 75s.; *Water Lily*, 344, same voyage, 76s. 3d. and 75s. respectively.

Coastwise freights are rather dull, but rates remain about the same as last week. There

is an increasing demand for vessels in the coal trade, which will employ a portion of our coasting vessels, and may cause more firmness in lumber freights. Vessels are being chartered for coals from Sydney to this port, at \$2.25 to \$2.50 per chaldron. We hear of the following charters:—*Arizona*, 124, *Helea Hastings*, 122, and *Village Belle*—all for Boston, at \$4; *Bine*, 131, Boston, laths, 75c.; *Impudence*, 115, Pawtucket, \$5.50; *Mary Ella*, 155, *J. D. Lincoln*, 250, and *Catherine John*, 149—all for Philadelphia, at \$5 and \$1; *Ella*, 102, Musquash to Boston, sleepers, 15c.; *George Kilburn*, 142, hence to Boston, pilings, 34c. 3/4 ft.
