General manager of the Grand Trunk, Mr. W. W. Wainwright, received the following statement: "We have had a very bad accident. There were two special trains containing 554 pilgrims, bound for St. Anne de Beauspre. One train left Sherbrooke at 8:30 a.m. and the other Northampton Mills, near Island Falls, at 8:30 a.m., and the two proceeded towards Chaudiere. This morning at 3:15, at Craig's Creek, the two trains collided."


