RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The Librarian desires to call attention to the following Rules and Regulations. He wishes it to be distinctly understood that they will be strictly enforced, as this is very necessary for the satisfactory condition of the Library. The teachers are requested to assist by seeing that their scholars keep these rules.

1. Note.—Catalogue of December, 1909, and Supplement of December, 1910, are cancelled, as all the books have been renumbered. Please destroy any copies you may have left.
2. Application for books must be made to Librarian before school opens.
3. Books must be returned in good condition every two weeks, and then can be renewed if desired. Failure to comply with this rule will render the borrower liable to a fine of five cents for every two weeks after the first two. This fine must be paid before another book will be given out, unless a very satisfactory excuse is given to the Librarian.
4. Readers are given one catalogue free; if lost, new ones may be procured for five cents each. New cards cost one cent.
5. Readers are expected to keep their cards marked with plenty of numbers of books desired, not less than twenty.
6. Books will not be exchanged again after being given out. If the book is not wanted, return it to the Library and keep the card until the next Boys' or Girls' Sunday.
7. Scholars will be responsible for Library Books given out to them. If lost or damaged the book must be replaced.
8. Books will be distributed after school is over, and scholars must remain in their classes to receive them.
9. When scholars are changed into other classes, the teachers should notify the Librarians at once, to prevent books being sent to wrong classes.
10. The Library will be opened at 2.30 every Sunday. Those wishing to procure books, or get any information, must apply before 3 o'clock. After that hour the Library wicket will be closed until school is over and the books have been distributed. The Librarians will wait for a few minutes then to attend to those who have good grievances only.
