Extract from the Public School Act, chapter sixty-four of the Consolidated Statutes of Ontario, authorizing this transaction.

120. Out of the share of the Legislative School Grant coming to Upper Canada, and the additional sums of money from time to time granted in aid of Common Schools, or in aid of Common and Grammar Schools in Upper Canada, and not otherwise expressly appropriated by law, the Governor in Council may authorize the expenditure of the following sums annually.

Through the Chief Superintendent of Education.

D. In providing the Grammar and Common Schools with Maps and Apparatus, upon the same terms, and in the same manner as books are provided for Public School Libraries—(i.e., one hundred per cent. on local appropriations of not less than five dollars each, accompanied by a form of application, sealed with a proper corporate seal as within.)
