

REPORT

OF THE

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT.

The Committee of Management beg to submit the thirty-fifth Annual Report of the proceedings of your Society.

During the past year your Society has provided seasonable and substantial aid in eighty cases of distress, comprising one hundred and twenty-nine individuals; of these seventeen have been sent home to England, fifty one have been assisted to enable them to proceed to Ontario and the West, and five to the Lower Ports, whilst fifty-five were relieved locally.

The expenditure for charitable purposes amounts to six hundred and forty-two dollars 10 cents, (\$642.10.)

The Society continues to be indebted to James A. Sewell, Esq., M.D., for his valuable services as physician and as member of the Charitable Committee.

The Treasurer's account which accompanies this report shows that the financial affairs of the Society are in a sound and prosperous state.

We have added to our list of members nine names; one honorary, seven ordinary, and one life member,—Mr. H. J. Pratten. The Society deplores the deaths of four members, Mr. John Brooke, Mr. Henry John Noad, (twice Vice-President,) Mr. Robert Stride and Mr. Joseph White.

Mr. White was an active member of the charitable committee for many years, and the judgment, diligence and kindness he ever manifested will be long gratefully remembered, by the Society; he also ably filled the office of President during two terms.

The last anniversary was celebrated by evening service in the Cathedral, when a sermon was preached by the Rev. C. F. Thorndike, prayers read by Rev. G. V. Housman, M.A., and Rev. M. M. Fothergill, Chaplains to the Society; with an appropriate musical service conducted by Mr. F. W. Mills, F. C. O., on which occasion a collection in aid of the wiends furnity of the Society was made.

The Right Revd. George Jehosaphat Mountain, D. D., D. C. L., Lord Bishop of Quebec, was the second son of Bishop Jacob Mountain, the first Anglican Bishop of Quebec. He was born 27th July, 1789, at Norwich, England, came to Canada with his father, 1793, and died after a brief illness at Barfield, his country seat, on 5th Jany, 1863. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebec, and was consecrated Bislop, 14th February, 1836. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebec, and was consecrated Bislop, 14th February, 1836. He was a diligent visitor among his flock. And in the dreadful visitations of cholera in 1832 and 1834, he literally lived night and day among the dying and the dead, while in 1847, when the province was visited with the plague of typhus fever, and the apoor emigrants were dying by thousands at the Quarantine station, the Bishop took his turn at Grosse Isle regularly with the rest of the clergy; and again when the cholera visited Quebec, in 1849 and 1854, he was diligent in visiting the hespitals. During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his life membership, contributed regularly to the Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times he

took a great interest in its proceedings.
