AN ELOPEMENT OF FOUR.

THEY ESCAPED FROM THE CITY OF QUEBEC.
A wife of an officer with her husband's clerk and a nephew with the servant, were found in New York.

ST. JOHN, July 28.—Detective Fahey has just obtained a letter piece of detection work, the results of which are the rescuing of a young woman from a life of shame and the rescuing of a husband and wife. The principals in the affair are residents of and well-known in Quebec. The story, as told by Fahey to a Herald reporter, is briefly as follows: A certain young Frenchman, whose name, however, is decidedly of English origin, was married about four months ago at a club in a well known restaurant in the city. Leaving there he sought the ancient capital and procured employment in one of the largest dry goods stores there. The proprietor of the place was rather addicted to over-indulgence in intoxicating beverages, and had for a partner a pretty young wife of some seven and twenty summers. The clerk, who by the way, was looking for a partner, was introduced to the fair sex over the long intercom of a dry goods shop, soon attracted the notice of the latter half of the proprietor. Opportunity was not wanting, as the clerk occupied lodgings over the shop, and a tender acquaintance gradually sprang up.

The "shop" was not altogether unaware of this ripening of affection, and after vainly expostulating with his wife, by way of a joke, went upon a gaudy and ostentatious spree that lasted eight days, during which he managed to make himself thoroughly intolerable to his wife and friends. Madame could not stand this, and after consultation with her clerk and the president of the board, determined to do this in style as she visited her husband's sale, of which she had the key, and abstracted therefrom the sum of \$4000 for travelling expenses. But this was not all. There was a remarkable pretty young man, who was the nephew of her husband, who was suspected of entertaining more than a passing fancy for the clerk. Accordingly, about ten days ago the quartette quietly disappeared. On the next morning the proprietor and his wife discovered the absence of his spouse and coming partially out of his sleep pointed to this city, where he had hoped to find the fugitives. In this, however, he was disappointed, and finally secured the services of Detective Fahey to hunt them down. That indefatigable functionary soon found out that the missing couple had gone directly to a Quebec to Richmond, Quebec, and after that to Montreal, where the detective and a friend left for New York a week ago last Saturday morning. On the way, they visited Cape Breton and spent about a week in vain for the lost ones. Monday was devoted to promoting Broadway and other public reports, and in the afternoon the clerk and his wife were seen at the corner of the street, and were followed them up Fifth avenue, and watching his opportunity Fahey stepped up to the young clerk and tapped him on the shoulder, calling him by name at the same time.

A scene of the utmost confusion ensued. The clerk recognized Fahey, and declared he had no other alternative but to flee. He fell down as he was supported. The wife flung herself at her husband's feet, begging for mercy. The nephew, who was great of mind, as soon as he saw the state of affairs started off at full speed up the avenue and was seen no more. The party, including the pretty domestic, was adjourned back to the room hired by Fahey, where the youthful abductor, who was great of mind, was interrogated at all. In the meanwhile, the wife begged her husband to forgive her, and declared she had left him because he was drinking, and asserted that her relations with the clerk were of a purely platonic nature.

After some further pleadings the husband began to waver and finally decided to take his erring wife back to Quebec and place her in a convent. The clerk was searched and some \$600 [that was left of the \$3,000], taken from him, after which he was left to show his nose in Quebec again. Further researches showed that the party had had a good time with the money, had bought clothes, jewelry and other trifles and were intending to open a French restaurant upon an expensive plan. They had established themselves in comfortable quarters and were living together regardless of expense. The party returned to Montreal, where the husband presented Detective Fahey with a check for \$500 as a reward for bringing the affair to a successful conclusion. The husband, wife and maid then left at once for their homes.

He Shot His Lady Love's Father.
BUTLIFE, July 28.—A special from Princeton, N.J., says the details of the murder on Saturday of Capt. Davis, a wealthy citizen of Worcester county, have just reached here. Irving J. Mills, a drummer in the employ of W. G. Dunsmuir & Co. of Baltimore had been for some time paying attention to Mrs. Mary E. Ross, a beautiful young widow and the daughter of Capt. Davis, against the wishes of the lady's father. During the captain's absence yesterday Mills called on Mrs. Ross, and the pair went out to the city in the evening they were met by Capt. Davis, in Dublin district. The irate father ordered Mrs. Ross to leave the carriage. The lady proceeded to obey, but Mills whipped up his horse in an endeavor to get away. Capt. Davis sprang from the horse's back, and Mrs. Ross became so enraged that he drew a revolver and fired. When Mrs. Ross stepped upon the ground it was to fall upon her father's corpse, he having been shot through the heart. The murderer fearing that the residents of Pocomoke city would take the law into their own hands drove to Princeton and gave himself up.

Greasy Blamed For Loss of Life.
NEW YORK, July 28.—Some of the men on the steamer Loch Garry say Greasy is to blame for the loss of his life. The party could easily have reached Littleton Island and have been saved, had a combined effort been made. The Strike at New York.
