## R E P O R T

OF THE

### Provincial Rifle Association of Nova Scotia.

THE Council submit their first report to the members of the Association, and beg to state that immediately after the formation of the Association the Annual Competition was decided to be held at Truro. It being then late in the season the weather turned out most unpropitious, so much so that it was almost impossible to continue the firing; on one of the days the competitors were fairly driven off the ground by the violence of the wind and rain. Many returned to their homes before the completion of the contest, consequently the firing was not as good as it would have been under more favourable and auspicious weather.

It is proposed that the Competition shall take place this year earlier in the season—about the latter part of August or beginning of September.\* The Council have had under their consideration the necessity of establishing a permanent range; but as yet have been unable to decide on a suitable place.

The Council have much pleasure in stating that His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief subscribed last year the handsome sum of Five Pounds to the funds of the Association, and a like sum was also given by Lady MacDonnell.

There were also received a donation of Five Pounds from the 1st Halifax Regiment, and the same amount from the 3rd Queen's Halifax Regiment; Fourteen Pounds from the

Windsor, Shubenacadie, and Halifax Volunteer Companies; One Hundred Pounds from 200 subscribers; and One Hundred Pounds from the Provincial Government, in all Two Hundred and Thirty-Four Pounds.

The amount received has been expended in prizes and in payment of expenses attending the meeting at Truro, except the sum of £7 15s. 6d. remaining in the hands of the Treasurer, whose accounts have been certified as correct by the Auditing Committee.

The Council also received for competition a Field-Officer's Bridle from Colonel Laurie, competed for by Field Officers; a Regulation Sword and Belt from Colonel Sinclair, competed for by Company Officers; and a double barreled Fowling Piece from Lieut-Colonel Jones, 1st Halifax Regiment, competed for by members of the Association.

The Annual Subscriptions were not so extended as hoped for; it is however expected the number will be considerably increased the present year. The object of the formation of the Association was not perhaps generally understood at the time; but now, having become more fully known, the Council are desirous that every Officer of the Local Forces will come forward and become Annual Subscribers—as well as many members from the different Volunteer Companies.

The President of the Association, Lieut-Colonel Pryor, addressed a letter to Lieut-General Knollys, Comptroller of the Household of the Prince of Wales, respectfully requesting His Royal Highness to become the Patron of the Association. The answer to this application has not yet been received.\*

The Council have much gratification in informing the members that an elegant Silver Cup of the value of £80 sterling has been presented by Major James C. Cogswell, 4th Queen's Halifax Regiment, to the Association, open to

competitors from all the Colonies, to be ealled "The Cogswell Challenge Cup."

The office of Umpire at the Competition was cheerfully undertaken by Colonel Laurie, I. F. O. M. The Council are greatly indebted for his ready, active and valuable assistance during the time of the meeting.

To the Adjutant-General and the Staff from his Office, the Council are similarly indebted for their zealous co-operation and valuable services—as also to many of the Militia and Volunteer Officers for assistance rendered on the field. To all the Council have to express their thanks and grateful acknowledgments.

## RULES AS AMENDED 1865.

---

1. This Association shall consist of all persons paying ten shillings per annum, or a donation of five pounds, to the Provincial Rifle Association.

2. Any County Regiment subscribing not less than Five Pounds, annually, to the funds of the Provincial Rifle Association, shall be considered as being in connection with it, and shall be entitled to a number of memberships of Non-commissioned Officers and Men in the proportion of one to every eight shillings and fourpence thus subscribed.

3. Volunteer Companies whose effective strength is over 60 shall pay to the Association Ten Dollars per annum, and shall be entitled to send six members to the competition. Volunteer Companies whose effective strength is under sixty shall pay eight dollars, and be entitled to send five members. No Volunteer Officer not being a subscriber to the Association will be allowed to compete.

4. All subscriptions from County Regiments shall be paid through the Commanding Officer of the respective Regiments.

5. The affairs of the Association shall be under the control of a Council, consisting *ex officio* of the Secretary and Treasurer for the time being, and also of not less than Fifteen Members nor more than Twenty Members, fifteen of whom shall be elected annually by ballot at the general meeting, and five subsequently by the Council—five to form a quorum.

6. The Annual Meeting of the Members of the Association for the election of a Council and other matters, shall be held on the first Monday in May in each year, at such place as may be named by the Council.

7. The Council shall meet quarterly, or oftener, if required by any two of its members, and keep minutes of its proceedings. It shall have power to elect new members to fill up any vacancy in the Council, and to appoint the Treasurer and Secretary, and shall be regulated in their proceedings by such rules or bye-laws as may from time to time be enacted by them for the regulation of all matters committed to its charge, subject to the approval of the Commander-in-Chief on all subjects of a purely military character.

8. There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons, named by the Council.

9. The Council shall choose from the members elected, a President, who shall be President of the Association.

10. There shall be Vice-Presidents. The Senior Militia Officers of Counties (not being unattached), who are subscribers, shall be *ex officio* Vice-Presidents. Should the Senior Officer not be a subscriber, the next in rank, being a subscriber, shall fill the office.

11. The prizes of the Association shall be open to the Militia and Volunteers of the Province of Nova Scotia, (being subscribers) on such terms, and at such times and places as may be fixed by the Council.

12. All competitors for prizes, (except for the all-comers prizes,) shall be required to appear in the uniform of their respective corps, and shall be certified by their Commanding Officers to be efficient in such Manual and Platoon and other military exercises as may be ordered by the Commander-in-Chief.

### \* B Y E - L A W S .

1. An Umpire shall be appointed by the Council. All disputed points shall be decided by the Umpire, whose decision shall be final.

2. An Officer shall be appointed to take command of all who may assemble to compete for the prizes, and maintain order and discipline on the field.

3. The size of the targets to be used shall be the same as laid down in the Army Musquetry Regulations, viz.:—

Up to 300 yards.....	2 Targets 4 x 6 feet. Bull's Eye 2 x 1 "
	Centre 4 x 2 "
300 to 600 yards .....	3 Targets 6 x 6 feet. Bull's Eye 2 x 2 "
	Centre 4 x 4 "
650 yards and upwards.....	4 Targets 8 x 6 feet. Bull's Eye 2 x 3 " Centre 4 x 6 "

Bull's Eyes to count 4. Centres 3. Outers 2

4. All distances up to 300 yards shall be fired off the shoulder. Beyond that distance, kneeling, unless off the shoulder.

5. No magnifying sights, fixed artificial rests, or hair triggers, shall be allowed at any competition, (except at that of the all comers.)

6. In all shooting for prizes the minimum pull of trigger shall not be less than six pounds.

7. Competitors shall, if required, submit their rifles for inspection before, during, or after firing.

8 PROVINCIAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION OF NOVA SCOTIA.

8. TIES.—1. Where prizes are competed for at *one* range only, ties shall fire *one* shot each at that range until the best shot be returned. 2. Where prizes are competed for at more than one range, ties shall fire *one* shot at the longest range until the best shot be returned.

9. Government ammunition, as supplied on the ground, shall be used. Any competitor (except for the all-comers prizes) infringing this rule shall be disqualified from competing for any prizes during the remainder of the meeting.

10. Any competitor discharging his rifle without having previously obtained permission from the Officer in command of the field, or of the Squad Commander, shall be fined 2 dollars, and in default of payment, be disqualified for competing for any prizes during the remainder of the meeting.

11. Competitors not allowed to change their squad, throughout the meeting, after having been once placed.

12. Volunteers and Militia allowed to compete in full or undress uniform.



## A P P E N D I X.

---

THE following account of the Rifle Competition at Bedford in 1865 is abridged from "THE HALIFAX REPORTER":—

The Annual Competition of the Provincial Rifle Association of Nova Scotia, held at the new range at Bedford, was commenced on the 5th September and continued the three following days. On the first day the sky was overcast, and a shower about noon sent all the idlers in search of shelter. His Excellency Sir Richard Graves MacDonnell arrived on the ground about half-past eleven o'clock, and was received by the guard with the customary honors. The competitors, about 250 in number, had at this time been formed into twelve squads, and placed opposite their targets at the 300-yard range. Opposite No. 1 target a rifle had been placed on a tripod, and after it had been sighted, Lady Macdonnell, advancing gracefully, and with a smiling face, pulled the trigger. Every one looked to see where the shot had struck. It was the first one, and a few seconds only elapsed before a white disc was displayed, signifying a bull's-eye. Immediately thereupon the firing commenced. It was determined, after a few rounds had been fired, to keep the men at the short ranges of all the competitions, before proceeding to the long ranges. The second competition was passed over, as the competitors from Prince Edward Island had not arrived. About two-thirds of the competitors in the first competition were disqualified, having failed to score eight at the first range. In the firing for the National Association Medal, not nearly so large a proportion were disqualified. Much praise is due to the officers in command of squads for the efficient manner in which they performed their duty. His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor was one of the competitors for the Ladies' Cup, but, scoring only eight, was disqualified, and "fell out" before the firing commenced at the long ranges.

On the second day the competitors fell in at nine o'clock, and were told-off to their respective squads. Scarcely had they reached their posts when the rain commenced falling in

torrents, with frequent showers during the remainder of the day. The firing at ranges 500 and 600 yards of the first competition, was finished about three p.m., and the third competition at 500 completed.

On the third day the weather was fine and all that could be desired. The squads were formed at half-past nine o'clock and marched to the 300-yard range, to commence the competition for the Cogswell Cup. Neither Canada nor New Brunswick sent competitors, but Prince Edward Island sent nine.

The morning of the fourth day was bright and clear, but the sky became overcast before the firing commenced, and from nine till past noon there were frequent showers of rain, though not sufficiently heavy to cause an intermission in the firing. In the early part of the forenoon the wind blew heavily, and all day the weather was cold. A large number of competitors fell in for the All-Comers' Prizes. The competition for the prizes presented to the Association commenced next, viz : A Silver-plated Tea Service, presented by Colonel Laurie, I. F.O. ; a Government Enfield Rifle, presented by Captain Clifford R. Kinnear, late 1st Halifax Regiment ; and a Silver Hunting Watch, presented by Alderman John McCulloch. 3 rounds ; 500 yards.

When the firing was finally concluded, the squads were marched to the front of the Lieutenant-Governor's tent to receive the prizes. His Excellency was present, accompanied by Lady MacDonnell, with a number of ladies and gentlemen from the city. The weather was not at all favorable for the ceremony, as a cold north-easter swept down the valley, under a dark and threatening sky.

#### PRESENTATION OF PRIZES.

---

THE prizes were displayed on a table in view of the competitors, and before his Excellency. When all was ready, Sir Richard addressed a few remarks to Col. Pryor. He said that before presenting the prizes, he wished to offer his congratulations with regard to the range selected, which he considered not only to be admirably adapted for the purposes for which it was intended, but as possessing other attractions, such as its convenience in point of distance from the city, and its picturesqueness. He was glad to think that he had been in any way instrumental in procuring so fine a locality, and

one which had within itself so many pleasing features. It was perhaps the last time he might have an opportunity of addressing those present, and he wished to bear testimony to the good temper and good discipline which had been preserved throughout the contest.

The names of the successful competitors were then called, and each in turn stepped to the front and advanced to the table, saluting his Excellency as they did so. The first to present himself was Sergeant-Major Hardwick, 4th King's County Regiment. In presenting him with the Provincial Rifle Association Challenge Gold Medal, his Excellency complimented the successful marksman upon his skill ; his score being 49. The medal was fastened upon his breast by Lady MacDonnell, amid hearty cheering. Lieut. Maloney, of the Mayflower (Halifax) Rifles, was then called to receive the second prize of £7 10s. in this competition. Next came the other successful competitors, some receiving money prizes, and others swords.

Before the presentation of the Cogswell Challenge Cup, His Excellency remarked upon the liberality of the donor, and eulogised the exquisite workmanship of the prize, which from its appearance, some might estimate at a glance far below its real value. Mrs. Cogswell then stepped forward and presented the Cup to Major D. McDonald, 5th Pictou County Regiment, the successful competitor, with the following graceful remarks :—“ I have great pleasure in presenting you with this Cup in token of your skill as a marksman. The numerous wars which have so rapidly succeeded each other during the last few years, have startled nations from lethargy into action, and on every side we hear the sound of Military preparation. The British Empire is sparing no pains to enable her to take a foremost place, and her Colonies are called on to prove themselves worthy of their mother by their courage, their skill, and their self-denial. This, our Province, has not been backward in answering to the call, so far as it has as yet been called upon to bestir itself. Through its Legislature it has testified its public zeal and liberality, and the readiness with which its Militia have discharged their duties, and the interest excited by such rifle contests as the one just now concluded, prove the warmth of individual feeling. It is for the purpose of showing his own interest in this great National movement, that my husband has instituted this prize, and he hopes that it will be received by his fellow countrymen on the western outline of the

British Empire in the spirit in which it is given. As a native and resident in this country, I join with my husband in desiring to see it take its stand as a brave and self-reliant land. As a woman I have a still deeper interest. Should war ever reach us, it is to the keen eyes and strong hands of men that we must look for protection from troubles too grave to be dwelt upon here; and your spirit must be roused when you reflect that on you are bent the eyes of mothers, wives, and sisters, as their natural protectors from wrong."

Three cheers followed, given for the winner of the Cup, and then three hearty ones for Mrs. Cogswell. Corporal Logan then stepped forward to receive the Medal of the National Rifle Association of England. (The Medal had not been received, but will be forwarded to him on its arrival from London.) Sergeant Major Hardwick again came forward to receive more of the numerous prizes obtained by him. His Excellency laughed and said, "I think, sir, I've seen your face before." Sergeant Sanford of the Halifax Volunteer Artillery next presented himself to receive the Ladies' Cup. Lady MacDonnell gracefully made the presentation, and trusted that the ladies of Nova Scotia would not fail to keep up this prize in future years. Lady MacDonnell presented the prizes awarded by the Ladies to the respective winners. Sergeant Sanford was informed that the Ladies' Cup would be handed to him on its arrival from England. His Excellency remarked upon the high number of points required in the short ranges of this Competition, as showing how high an opinion the ladies of Nova Scotia had of the skill of the riflemen, and how, in the contest, the latter had shown they were deserving of the compliment. Major W. H. Creighton, 1st Brigade Halifax Militia Artillery, next came forward as the winner of the Tea Service. Colonel Laurie regretted that the prize had not yet arrived from England, but would have much pleasure in handing it to the winner on its arrival. He would say, however, that he had intended *it should go to the Country!*

\* The Enfield Rifle was then presented to Lieut. James Kean, 1st Digby County Regiment, and the Watch to Major John MacKay, 7th Colchester County Regiment.

The other presentations having been made, his Excellency proposed three cheers for her Majesty the Queen, which were given with a will. Cheer upon cheer followed, for Sir Richard MacDonnell, Lady MacDonnell, Lt.-Col. Pryor, &c., and the assembly dispersed.

## PRESENTATION OF THE "LADIES' CUP."

THIS interesting ceremony came off yesterday afternoon in Temperance Hall. A great deal of interest was manifested by the community in connection with the matter. There was a very large attendance at the Hall, of all ages and both sexes. A Guard of Honour from the "Scottish Volunteers" and the "Halifax Rifles," with the Band of the Halifax Volunteer Battalion, and Queen's Colour, received their Excellencies the Lieutenant Governor and the Major General, in front of the building; and the First Battery Volunteer Artillery, to which corps the recipient of the "Ladies' Cup" belongs, lined the passage from the entrance to the platform in the Hall. Several ladies occupied the dais, on which were also seated the distinguished personages above named. The Artillery having taken up a position in front of the platform, his Excellency Sir W. F. Williams, K. C. B., was called to the Chair by Colonel Henry Pryor. His Excellency expressed the great pleasure it gave him to be present on so interesting an occasion, and his admiration for the ladies of Halifax who had originated it. Sir Fenwick gave a brief outline of the history of the Volunteer movement in Great Britain and Canada, during the past six years. When, in 1859, he was appointed Commander-in-Chief in British North America, the Volunteer movement was only beginning to take effect in the mother country; and after an absence of little more than five years he found on his return the Force to number 170,000. He expected to witness comparatively similar results in this his native land. His Excellency, in his soldier-like speech, paid a high compliment to the Halifax Volunteers generally, and the Artillery in particular. The Cup was gracefully presented by Mrs. Young, wife of his Honor the Chief Justice, with the following remarks: "In the absence of Lady MacDonnell, I have great pleasure, on behalf of the Ladies' Committee, in presenting you with this splendid Cup, awarded to you as a tribute to your skill, and with subsequent triumphs, I hope, will enable you to retain it as a permanent memento and heirloom,"—which was responded to by Sergeant Sanford in a manly and modest manner. General Doyle, being called upon by General Williams, made one of his happiest addresses, which drew down the house. Upon the chair

being vacated by the Lieutenant-Governor and the Major-General called thereto, his Honor the Chief Justice proposed a vote of thanks to the former, and in a brief and eloquent oration alluded to the benign influence of woman in every department of life. At the close of the ceremonies, three cheers were given for the Queen, the Ladies, the Lieutenant-Governor, the Major-General, and the Chief Justice. The Citizen Soldiers, who looked grandly, then escorted the Cup to the residence of Sergeant Sanford, and subsequently marched to their respective orderly rooms, the Band of the Artillery and the Pipes of the Volunteers playing popular airs.
