SEVENTY THOUSAND VISITORS AT THE EXHIBITION.

Gratifying increase in receipts—The afternoon's sport in the Ring—Winners at the Dog Show—Meeting of Canadian Fair Managers—The Chorus of Congratulation Unchecked.
