CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS

ONTARIO.

Lumber is moving more briskly than last week. Dealers who have been running along for some time with light supplies are now stocking up to some extent, and invariably request that the lumber be shipped immediately. The need of the stock and the fear of an inadequate supply of cars for transportation are responsible for this urgency. The most activity is confined to the cities, where the requirement for building purposes is quite large. Common boards in pine are meeting with a ready sale, while hemlock in boards and dimension timber is in steady request. The general hardwood trade is showing more life under the lead of oak and birch. The former is slightly firmer in price, as the supply is by no means large. Basswood still lags, the substitution of other woods last year owing to its abnormal scarcity having affected the demand this season. Interior huishing stock is active, as buildings have now advanced to the point where they are ready for this work.

There is an enlarged demand for pine lath and higher prices are predicted. It is believed that the supply will not last until the mills resume operations next spring, as there is not a large stock at the mills in Ontario and a decided shortage has developed in the Lake Superior district

OUTSIEC AND NEW DALBSWICK

Spruce lumber prices are being main tained, but trade is still on the quiet side. There is a fairly active movement of stock in a retail way in Montreal, where building operations are being pushed with some vivor. In the country districts, however, there is not much doing and stocks at the mills are accumulating. The supply of inch lumber in both spruce, and hen lock is large and prices of this size are leasier. There has been a further decline in the price of square and wanes pine timberabe best price obtainable at Quebec for 19-to 20-inch waney being about 65 cents. Square birch is also a shade weaker.

UNITED STATES.

The lumber business in the United States is proceeding along very satisfactory lines. Business in July was better than in August. and September so far has shown a substantial improvement over last month. Evidence develops almost every day that stocks at the producing points are not large and are in strong hands, and there is little doubt as to the maintenance of prices. Wholesale dealers report an increased enquiry for white pine and a larger movement is looked for next month. Lastern retail dealers are finding, that it is impossible to secure lumber by making an offer lower than the prices asked by the wholesalers, who in turn have been prevented from lowering their quotations owing to the firm attitude of the manufacturers. The box business is for the first time in many months showing, signs of an unsettled condition, and consequently has lumber is not quite as firm as it was. Pennsylvania producers have advanced the base price of hemlock \$1 per thousand to \$16.50, but the basis at Buffalo continues at \$15.50. The advance in the price of yellow pine lumber has been helpful to hemlock. Spruce prices are being well maintained, from the manufacturers standpoint, spruce has not looked so promising for some months as it does now, and as the mils will soon cease operating for the season, prices are not likely to be ower this year

The demand for hardwood lumber is steadily expanding. Plan cak is said to be selling \$2 per thousand higher than it did one month ago, with some doubt as to the abiaty of the manufacturers to meet the requirement. All other kinds are steady with the exception of hasswood, which is being effered occasionally at lower prices. The Wisconsin Hardwood Lumbermen's Association, have adopted a new price list which shows that there is the strongest confidence in the fature and that prices are expected to be consider ably higher before lanuary

Reports lately received of the Buttsh lumber market have a more optimistic hue than for some time past. There is undoubtedly a better feeling and more disposition to purchase, but the heavy stocks that are carried at many of the ports keep the trade in a depressed condition and prevent any marked recovery in prices. These stocks have accumulated during the past year, when the consumption of lumber was unusually light. For the thirty-six weeks ending September 10th, this year's consumption of deals, etc., at London is some ten thousands standards less than for the corresponding period of 1903. There is still slight danger of further weakness as a result of consignment cargoes, but it no large quantity of stock is forced upon the market in this way, the near future should witness some improvement both in demand and prices. The feeling is gaining ground even among importers that prices have seen their worst. The Timber News states that spruce deals are decidedly firmer and that there is a distinct advance in values. The volume offering is less than usual at this season of the year and there are no indications so far of an excessive supply. Birch planks continue to be asked 'or, and as the supply is smaller than usual, prices will probably be fully maintained. Birch logs are not in much demand. Hemlock is readily saleable, but shippers have restricted their output and will not now take orders at the figures which have prevailed.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The Forster Lumber Company is reported to have purchased the output of the McRae Company's mill at Hosmer, B.C.

The W. & A. McArthur Company, of Little Current, Ont., will take out about 20,000,000 feet of logs during the coming winter.

At St. John, N.B., last week, about 1,000,000 feet of spruce logs belonging to the R. A. Estey Estate were sold to Henry Miller, of St. John, at \$9.50 a thousand.

C. H. LaBillois, Commissioner of Public Works, Fredericton, N. B., is asking for tenders up to Movember 7th for the supply

of lumber required for flooring the Marysville steel highway bridge.

The Scott Lamber Company, of Fredericton, N. B., have been notified that the schooner Annie Harper, loaded by them with lumber for the Boston market, has been wrecked in the Bay of Fundy. It is understood that the cargo was well insured.

The logs belonging to the St. John Lum. ber Company which broke away at Van Buren during the late freshet, are being raited at the Mitchell boom at Fredericton, N.B., and will be towed to St. John. They are mostly small logs, averaging only about 1,200 feet to the joint

The head of the corporatio drive on the St. John river was at Briste., N.B., on September 22nd. There is about 4,000,000 teet in the drive. Although perations at the booms are progressing satisfactorily, it is not believed Ithat the work will be finished this fall, and about 10,000,000 feet of logs may have to be stored for the win-

Messrs, S. P. Musson, Son & Company, in their report of September 10th, state: "There have been no arrivals in either white pine or spruce during the fortnight, but, a mentioned in our last, we placed a cargo of former for this month's shipment at \$26 for shippers and \$20 for second quality. In spruce two cargoes have been placed—one for September shipment at \$22.50 and \$18.50 for shippers and second quality, and one for October shipment at \$21.50 and \$16.50. There is not much enquiry for white pine just now. but spruce .. inquired for, most of the dealers' yards being here, and we think a prompt arrival would do well. The only receipt of shingles to note is 65,000 Long Cedar by the steamer "Ocamo," which were sold at \$5.66; bo'h these and Dimension are wanted. The 'Success' is looked for with principally Long, which should bring full prices. For Cedar Laying, of usual description, there is not much enquiry, but we understand some Clears and Second Clears have been placed for future delivery at \$3.85 and \$4 for the former, and \$3.45 and \$3.50 for the latter. We could not venture a higher valuation than \$2.10 for the usual Laying, as dealers always have some.

WISCONSIN HARDWOOD PRICES.

The ninth annual meeting of the Wisconsin Hardwood Lumbermen's Association was held at Oshkosh, Wis., on September 20th. In discussing the price list, Mr. E. P. Arpin, chairman of the Price List Committee, stated that there did not seem to be any trouble in selling log run elm, 2 inch, at \$24. No. 3 Common was in good demand and No. 2 was holding up well. The property comprises 100,000 acres of timber limits, chiefly spruce, the Great Salmon river mill, a store, two schoosers and several 'uildings. The price paid is said to lave been in the vicinity of \$500,000. The property was purchased fourteen years ago by Mr. Bostwick from the Davidson Estate, since which time it has been greatly improved.

It is understood to be the purpose of the new owners to cut logs during the coming winter and to operate under the name of the Bay Shore Lumber Company.


