



BAY RUM AND FLORIDA WATER

OTTAWA, 11 June, 1913.

Sir,—I have the honour to hand you a report dealing with thirty-five samples purchased as Bay Rum, and an equal number of samples purchased as Florida Water, in February and March last.

Bay Rum is not described in the British Pharmacopoeia. It is defined as Spirit of Myrcia (*Spiritus Myrciae*) in the United States Pharmacopoeia of 1890 (seventh revision) and is there required to be made so that 2,000 cubic centimetres contain 1,220 cubic centimetres of Alcohol (95.1 per cent. volume ethyl alcohol). It is omitted from the Eighth revision of the U.S.P. (1900).

Florida Water has not, so far as I know, ever had any official recognition. It appears to be a solution of essential oils in more or less dilute alcohol.

Complaints have been made, on more than one occasion, to this Department, that the articles above named are sometimes prepared with the unacknowledged use of wood alcohol (*Columbian Spirit*) instead of ethyl alcohol.

7-8 Edward VII, Chap. six (assented to 10th April, 1908), Sec. 7 is as follows:—

“Section 266 of the said Act (Inland Revenue Act, Chap. 51, R.S., 1906) is amended by adding the following subsection thereto:—

2. Every person who uses methyl alcohol, or spirits containing methyl alcohol, in any form, in any pharmaceutical, medicinal or other preparation intended for external use shall affix to the vessel containing the said preparation a label stating, in black letters not less than one-fourth of an inch in height, the presence of methyl alcohol therein; and every person violating the provisions of this subsection shall incur a penalty not less than fifty dollars and not exceeding two hundred dollars.”

The following samples sold as Bay Rum contain methyl alcohol:—

No. 37185. There is nothing on the label or in the conditions of sale to indicate that methyl alcohol is present. The article is judged to be adulterated; but it may be that the word **ILLEGALLY SOLD** would better describe the case.

No. 37186. Contains methyl alcohol along with ethyl alcohol, and is probably made with methylated spirit. There is nothing on the label to indicate presence of methyl alcohol, and it must be judged similarly to the above.

No. 51236. Contains methyl and ethyl alcohols. The words "methyl alcohol" are written, scarcely legibly, upon the label, which is a written one; the words "Bay Rum" being however quite distinct. I have judged this case as doubtful; but in strict interpretation of the subsection above-quoted where the presence of methyl alcohol is required to be stated "in black letters not less than one-fourth of an inch in height," there can be no doubt that the article is illegal.

No. 51754. Is made with methyl alcohol. The label is a printed one and reads: "Genuine Imported Bay Rum". The word "Methyl" is written above, and between, the words "Genuine" and "Imported"—and is quite distinct. I have judged the sample as "doubtful" from the fact that the word "Methyl" is not an integral part of the label, as printed.

No. 51593. The sample is made with methyl alcohol. It is labelled "Genuine Imported Bay Rum," and contains no statement of the presence of methyl alcohol. It is therefore sold illegally.

No. 51595. This sample is labelled "Bay Rum," and has no mention of methyl alcohol, which has been used in its manufacture. I have judged it to be adulterated, or sold illegally.

FLORIDA WATER.

No. 46914. Contains methyl alcohol. It is labelled "Royal Florida Water" with no declaration of the presence of methyl alcohol. Illegally sold.

No. 51243. Is labelled "Florida Water" and contains no mention of methyl alcohol, although it is entirely made from this. It is sold illegally.

No. 57051. Is labelled "Florida Water" without mention of methyl alcohol, though made entirely from this. Is illegally sold.

No. 57161. Labelled "Holman's Florida Toilet Water" without mention of methyl alcohol which is present. It is therefore sold illegally.

I beg to recommend publication of this report as Bulletin No. 260.
