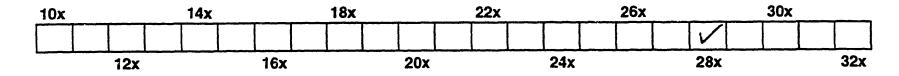

## BILL

[No. 427.

### An Act to make provision for the erection of certain Public Buildings at Toronto, for the better accommodation of the Government and of the Legislature, at that City.

WEEREAS it is expedient that ample accommodation should be provi- Preamble. ded at Toronto for the residence of the Governor General, for the two Houses of the Provincial Parliament, and for the various Departments of the Public Service, before the time when the Sittings of the Legislature, and 5 consequently the Seat of the Provincial Government, will, under the existing

- arrangements, be transferred for four years to the said City: And whereas the buildings heretofore used for the said purposes in the said City are wholly inadequate therefor, and the ground on which they stand, is coming rapidly to be within the commercial and business portion of the City, so that while
- 10 it will be every year less adapted to the purposes to which it has been hitherto applied, its value will become so great that it can no longer be so applied with a due regard to economy, at the same time that its application to such purposes would stand greatly in the way of improvements urgently required in the said City for commercial and business purposes: 15 And whereas the site hereinafter mentioned is the most eligible for the pur-
- poses aforesaid : Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That a sum not exceeding fifty thousand pounds (in addition to the sum £50,000 apof ten thousand pounds already appropriated for a new Government House) propriated be appropriated for the purpose of erecting a Government House, a buildings at 20 Parliament House, and buildings for the accommodation of the several Public at Toronto.

- Departments, with the requisite appurtenances, on such portion of the ground in the said City of Toronto, and lying at the Head of the College site. Avenue, and not required for Collegiate purposes, as may be found requisite for such building, and the proper appurtenances thereto: and that such
- 25 portion of the said ground as shall by the Governor in Council be deemed requisite for the purposes aforesaid, shall be set off by the Commissioners of Public Works, and shall be vested in the Crown for the Public uses of the Province.

II. And be it enacted, That the ground which shall be so set off and Ground taken 30 taken for the purposes aforesaid, shall be valued by competent persons to for such site be appointed by the Governor, and that the interest of the value thereof so how paid for. ascertained, at six per cent. per annum shall be paid yearly out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the credit of the University Income Fund, and shall form part thereof.

III. And be it enacted, That the said sum of fifty thousand pounds From what 35 shall be paid out of the Permanent Fund appropriated for the support of the fund £50,000 said University and University College, and that the interest thereon at shall be paid.

six per cent. per annum be paid yearly but of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the credit of the University Income Fund; Provided that such portion (if any) of the said fifty thousand pounds as may be required before the said Permanent Fund shall produce a sufficient sum, may 5 be taken in the mean time out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, to be repaid to the same from the said Permanent Fund.

And be it enacted, That the land upon which the present Govern- Site of prement House and Parliament Buildings at Toronto are situate, with the sent buildings ground and water lots in front thereof shall be sold by public auction in such to be sold, &c. ground and water lots in front thereof, shall be sold by public auction in such

- 10 lots and at such time or times and upon such terms and conditions as the Governor in Council shall deem best for the public interest; and the proceeds of such sale shall form part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, a sufficient amount thereof being invested in Provincial Securities by the Receiver General to produce yearly an amount of interest equal to that payable to
- 15 the University Income Fund, as hereinbefore mentioned; and the lands so sold shall be granted and conveyed to the respective Purchasers by Letters Patent, in which nevertheless any conditions whatever upon which the lands may have been sold may be inserted, and such conditions shall be enforced by all Courts of Law or Equity, whether they be or be not such as are in other cases held to be consistent with a grant.

V. And be it enacted, that all sums payable under this Act out of any Accounting public monies in the hands of the Receiver General shall be paid upon clause. warrant of the Governor; and that all sums of money expended under this Act shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors 25 through the Lords' Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, or in such

manner and form as Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors shall direct, and that an account thereof shall be laid before both Houses of the Provincial Parliament within fifteen days after the opening of the then next Session thereof.
