







## THE SOUVENIR ROSE.

This beautiful ornament represents on the exterior a splendid full blown rose with its graceful form and incomparable tints.

At first sight, the flower seems to be a flat piece of thick cardboard, but by carefully introducing the nail between the folds of the paper, it will be found capable of being opened again and again, until it attains somewhat the form of a circle, which is covered on every side with beautifully executed steel-engravings of various edifices and other objects of general interest. Thus, the LONDON ROSE, for example, contains a number of vignette views of some of the most remarkable edifices in the Metropolis, comprising St. Paul's Cathedral, the New Houses of Parliament, Greenwich Hospital, the Royal Exchange, and a host of others equally interesting.

These pretty ornaments serve as excellent SOUVENIRS of the remarkable places which they represent, and form at the same time very suitable and pleasing presents for tourists and others to carry back to their friends at home.
