HOME AND COLONIAL TOBACCO.

Substantial Prices for the Best Specimens of the Leaf—The Conditions.

Two prizes of fifty quints each are offered by the Tobacco Commission of the London Chamber of Commerce, to be awarded respectively for the best specimen of tobacco grown in the United Kingdom, and for the best specimen in India, or in any of the British colonies and possessions.

These prizes are given as a means of definitely ascertaining how far the above sources of tobacco supply are to be supplied, and to what extent, if any, these sources can compete in quality and price with those of foreign countries, from which the consumption of the world has hitherto been chiefly drawn.

It is with this object in view, and for the purpose of having a fair competition, as applicable to the competition which is invited, and they are such as are thought the most expedient for the purpose in view.

The tobacco trade section of the London Chamber of Commerce shall, for the purpose of holding on the 25th of the specimens coming to be the prize, appoint a jury of seven persons, who will be selected by the London Chamber of Commerce.

Each specimen submitted for the competition shall consist of a minimum quantity of tobacco grown in the United Kingdom, and therefore not less than 50 lbs. in weight.
