

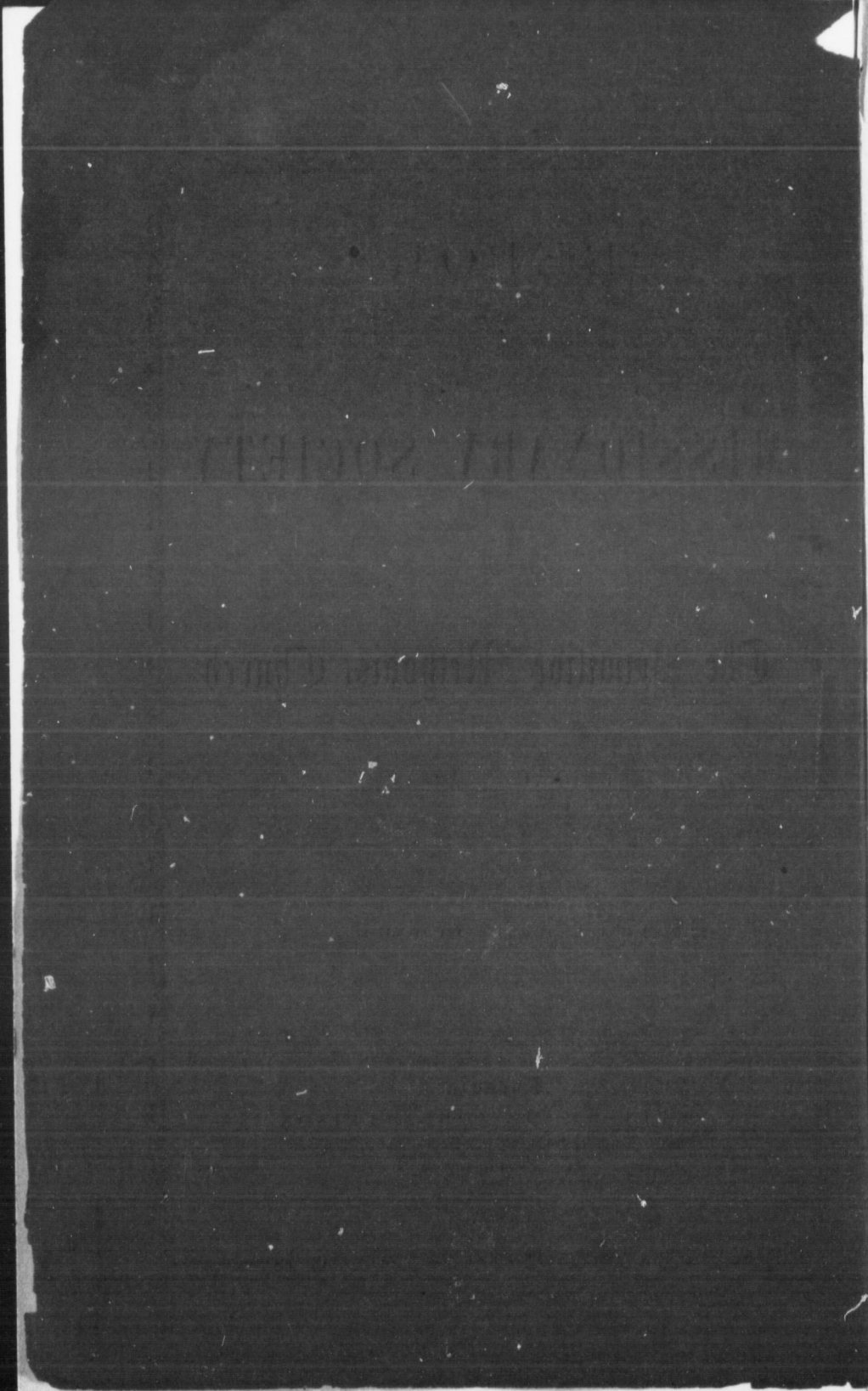

FOR THE YEAR ENDING 13TH JUNE, 1865.

The Missionary Committee, to the Friends of Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada West.

It affords us much pleasure once more to submit our yearly Report to our Friends, Missionary Collectors, Subscribers, and others, to review our Missions, and to examine, as on former occasions, what has been generously granted for their extension and support.

We are glad to announce, that during the year progress has been made; and from recent letters received from several Stations we learn that revivals of religion have taken place; many persons, young and old, have been awakened and converted; and several, whose obituaries have been inserted in the *Christian Journal*, have departed, to be "for ever with the Lord."

Many striking and affecting incidents have occurred in the prosecution of the work, demonstrating the divinity of the Mission, and the presence of the Holy Ghost in the operations of the Missionaries, which for want of space we cannot at present enumerate, but which are preserved for future use and reference.

We have now on our roll 36 Mission Stations, around each of which there is on an average about six preaching places. We have during the year formed five distinct Mission Stations, and taken out six fresh Missionaries. Several NEW CHURCHES have been dedicated, and a few are in progress, with PARSONAGES in connection.

Our financial position is not so satisfactory as we could wish it to be, and as it ought to be; for during the last two years especially, by extending our work, furnishing Parsonages required for additional married Missionaries, heavy removal expenses, apportioning grants too large for the anticipated income, and otherwise by various payments exceeding our yearly estimates, and which were all neces-

sary and imperative, our General Treasurer is consequently very considerably overdrawn. We are sanguine however in supposing that our friends in point of numbers and wealth, by increasing their subscriptions, could soon put us to rights in our balance sheet, and not suffer the cause to be crippled, nor any of the Stations to be abandoned; for we believe there is not one but in a greater or less degree is succeeding in saving souls. Besides, we are constantly pressed to take up NEW GROUND; and just now the sound is in our ears to send a Missionary to this locality and the other, which is greatly needed.

It is thought by some of our friends that the Missionary Committee has on its hands at present too many Missions to manage, and consequently too small an income to sustain them, even at the rate of salary which each Missionary receives. Hence it is frequently said, "why are not certain Stations we could name self-sustaining, but still continue dependent on the Mission funds?" In answer to this, it may perhaps be replied that several would have become independent had they not, as a class of central Stations, detached their outposts, or preaching places, ranging thirty or forty miles distant, and made them into new Missions; consequently, in doing this they weakened their numbers and finances, and therefore some time must be allowed for those central Stations to recover their strength, in order to be self-sustaining. Take a case or two for instance. London, C.W., was begun in 1854; it has detached Caradoc, MacGillivray, parts of Plympton, and other Stations. Kingston was once about self-sustaining, but it divided off Collinsby, Portland, Hinchinbrook, and parts of others. The same line of explanation will apply to other Missionary Centres, as Brant, Peel and Wellesley, &c. Guelph, as a Centre, with two Missionaries, was at different periods about independent of the funds, extending its preaching appointments through thirteen Townships, but is now contracted to a few miles in extent by the same cause, therefore assistance for a while longer must be given, until this class of Missions are prepared to support their present Missionaries; and we are glad to say that several are rising to the desired independence.

We had prepared to lay before our subscribers an historical account of each Mission, showing the date of commencement, how begun, Membership in the first year compared with the Membership at present, new Churches built on each Station, number of preach-

ing appointments, and other information, but we judged such accounts at present would be too elaborate; we therefore reserve such statistics, to be used in some other way, for reference.

In conclusion, it is necessary to say, our engagements and liabilities are being considerably increased, so that, as compared with last year at this time, the Treasurer's account is considerably overdrawn. It will therefore be borne in mind, that if we attempt further extension, or even hold our present ground, our revenue must be increased. We have in our connexional paper (the *Christian Journal*) laid these considerations before our Churches, and especially in our printed Conference Minutes for this year. We trust therefore that our entire membership and friends of Canadian Missions will, when next applied to at the Missionary Meetings and by the Collectors, respond with a noble and Christian liberality.

There never was a period in the history of our advance in which our enterprise required more additional effort than the present. And is not the cause of Missions, and these in particular, worthy of our confidence, our means, our sacrifices? What are the splendours of wealth, the honours of ambition, and the advantages of power, in this transitory life, compared with an interest in this cause? Everything that we can conceive here, in the face of this question, appears to diminish into insignificance, and at once to acknowledge the majesty and glory of a work like this, which lays hold with such a grasp upon both the present and eternal destinies of man.

“Haste, then, ye days of glory, when the light
New beaming from the star of prophecy
Shall fade, absorbed in perfect vision bright;
When Zion's watchmen, seeing eye to eye,
From all her walls shall shout salvation nigh;
When with the herald's voice
Re-echoing wilds rejoice,
And loud winds waft it to the listening sky.”

REMARKS.

1st. The General Committee wish to express its gratitude to the numerous DONORS to the Jubilee Fund; and rejoices that at the Public Meetings held throughout the Province much valuable information was diffused relative to the origin and progress of our Denomination, which has resulted in the sympathy of large numbers of the people, and the increasing extension and stability of our cause in Canada.

2nd. The grant made to the Book Room from the FUND was expended in Book Stock, which is nearly all sold, and the cash received paid to the General Treasurer, and appropriated under the direction of the General Missionary Committee, to carry on the Missionary Work, principally on New Mission Stations.

3rd. From the Balance Sheet it will be seen that the largest portion of the Fund has been devoted to the JUBILEE MISSION, which was commenced in October, 1861, in the Huron District, where the gospel was greatly needed. The success of the enterprise is shown from the late Conference Report of the Station, which includes 112 Members, 2 Missionaries, 9 Local Preachers, 11 Class Leaders, 4 Connexional Churches erected, 8 other Preaching Places established, 1 Sunday School, and 86 Scholars. We trust, therefore, that the Jubilee Mission will very shortly be self-sustaining, and in its turn assist with its means the General Missionary Committee to originate other Mission Stations in the Province.
