

THE ROMAN STATES.—A letter from Rome, of the 2nd inst., says: The people of Rome are at this moment well enough disposed to receive the Pope, and even more than ever clamorous for his return. Political, religious, and moral considerations are in the scale; or rather the absence of them, in consequence of a few stragglers arriving, among the shopkeepers who are driving out the Holy Father's men from their shops, and all alike demand the immediate return. The same dread of clerical interference prevails, and there are plenty of Republicans still ready to avail themselves of any favorable occasion; but with the anxiety anything a better than the present, and the failure of those measures by which so much ready money in other hands was secured.

It is stated that M. de Corcellis has made a long report to the French Government on the subject of the Achille, who still resides in the castle of St. Angelo, explaining the grounds on which the arrest was made, and the reasons why he could not be released. The report was read to the Chamber, and the Government decided to release the Achille, and to allow him to return to Rome with M. de Corcellis, on the declaration of the latter that the Achille is in a state of perfect tranquility.
