About four thousand immigrants have arrived in Winnipeg already this season.

It is alleged that a lead mine has been discovered on the mountain about eight miles south of Hamilton.

The six weeks' strike of the Canada Cotton Company's employees at Cornwall was settled by arbitration on Saturday, and work resumed.

The premier of Norway is being put forward as a candidate for the seat in the Dominion Senate in the event of Senator Scholten being appointed Lieutenant Governor of Manitoba.

Protestants in Montreal are indignant at the proposed erection of a statue of the Virgin Mary in Mount Royal park, and a movement has been started to get up a counter petition against the project.

The balance sheet of the City Treasurer of Toronto for 1887 shows total receipts from all sources amounting to \$3,726,477, against an expenditure of \$3,712,832; cash on hand at the close of the year, \$29,745.

Mayor Clarke, of Toronto, was notified that the Toronto University authorities had decided to cancel the lease of the Queen's Park entered into between the University and the Corporation on last January, 1887.

Extensive improvements are being carried out by the Government at Kingston penitentiary, the work which will be paid for by the convict, will cost three hundred and \$40,000, and will take three years to complete.

A very large and influential deputation from Quebec interviewed Sir John Macdonald recently for the purpose of obtaining Government aid for the construction of a bridge over the St. Lawrence from Quebec to Point Leve.

Gabriel Dumont arrived in Montreal on Sunday night, and is expected to stay about two weeks in that city. He says his object in coming to Canada is to help his fellow countrymen in the rebellion, and also to travel throughout the Dominion, afterwards taking a trip to France.

At the Kent Avenue, at Chatham, James Macoy, having from Detroit, was found guilty of having committed the crime of outrage at the house of Licensee Lapointe, Evans, of Chatham, on the night of January 29th, and sentenced to fourteen years in the Kingston Penitentiary.

Senator Abbott has been nominated by the Bank of Montreal directors to succeed the recently deceased Mr. G. B. Macdonald, and will be appointed at the expiration of thirty days. Mr. Abbott's appointment necessitates his withdrawal from the Merchants' Bank, of which he has been a director for some years.

The estimates for the Province of British Columbia for the year ending June 30th, 1888, were submitted to the Legislature last week. The total receipts are estimated at \$610,381, and the expenditures at \$789,839, leaving a deficit of \$179,458. This amount will probably be made up from the million dollar loan fund.

A settlement has just been effected of the outstanding dispute between the Government and the Niagara White Grape Company of Lockport, New York, which arose through the sale of a large number of grape vines the company had distributed throughout Ontario. From 1882 to 1886 the company sold vines to the value of \$10,000. They were planted and were to be paid for in ten annual instalments, when each instalment the Canadian Government notified the company that they had been fraudulently passing their vines to other growers.

The vines sold at \$1.50, and were entered for duty at the rate of 15 cents each. The Government on this occasion has not immediately seized all the vines the company had distributed throughout Ontario and notified the purchaser that the vines were no more instalments until the claim for customs duties had been settled. The Customs Department demanded \$18,000 and refused to release the vines until that amount was paid. The Government now accept \$12,000 at once, and the balance of the amount expended incurred. The memorandum of agreement states that this is done in consideration of the production of a satisfactory receipt for the vines.

The "Guardian's" honest convictions.—To find an eulogy on the speech delivered by the late Hon. Thos. White in Truro, nearly 40 years ago, in last week's "Guardian," is most amazing and quite in keeping with the actions of the "Get Party." But Mr. Laurier's outburst of loyalty in the House of Commons the other day, it comes too late. If the "Guardian" thanks the late Minister of Interior who one of the best speeches ever delivered in Truro, why had he not the honesty to say so at the time.

Mr. White's speech is no better to-day because he has fallen a "martyr" to public duty. But it was on the evening it was delivered at Truro. The "Guardian," as a public journalist, has done wrong in withholding its opinion so long. Should the editorial members of the Dominion cabinet be wared to read in the columns of our contemporary, sentiments vastly different from those uttered about them while in life. We cannot see why a man must die in order to get some men to speak their honest convictions about him. Sympathy expressed at the proper time often lightens the burden of life, but it is useless when our friends have passed beyond its reach.

Prince Alexander and Princess Victoria, daughter of Emperor Frederick, are at present in the role of unhappy lovers, being prevented from marriage by a grain old statesman, for "political reasons." It generally happens in this country that the parents object, but the present case is reversed. Bismarck has his hands full in his present quarrel with Queen Victoria of Prussia and Queen Victoria of England. Bismarck is the king of diplomacy, but a pair of queens will beat a king every time.

An editorial on the police force has been unavoidably crowded out this week, but will appear in next issue.

School Bill.

A second time the Local Government has refused to pass a bill that the school section of Acadia Mines is justly entitled to. We wonder what excuse our representatives will give for refusing justice to this section? About a year and a half ago a petition was circulated and very largely signed, asking the Local Government to pass a bill that would permit all the property owned by residents of the municipality, and situated in Acadia Mines to pay school rates here.

A petition was also presented to the government, signed by many who did not care whether this property paid its taxes in Acadia Mines or at the North Pole. Our representatives very wisely asked for time to inquire into this matter and ascertain whether or not it would be just to introduce special legislation for this district. Time was given them to learn the true state of affairs, and so thoroughly were they convinced of the justice of our petition that they framed a bill and presented it to parliament during the late session. The bill passed the second reading in due time, and was then referred to the committee on law amendments, where it remained for some time. While the bill was before this committee those opposed to it did their utmost to defend it, and as a result it was thrown out, so again justice is denied to the school section by the hands of our Local Government.

Other places have no difficulty in procuring similar bills, while in similar situations. Any sane man cannot but acknowledge the justice of such a bill.

There are over forty houses in Acadia Mines owned by persons residing in other parts of the county. These houses have been paying a yearly rental of over \$1000, and that when rents were low. Now, as rents have advanced about 20 per cent, the rental will be at the best about \$2400. Many of these houses have paid the owners more than it cost to build them, as the majority of the landlords were very cheaply built, yet the landlords are unwilling to contribute a small amount to the support of the school. This property is greatly enhanced in value by being situated here, e. g.—a house that rents for six dollars per month here would not bring over \$3 dollars where the owner resides. Again, these houses are occupied by those who send many children to school. Our schools are thus crowded, and more teachers have to be employed on account of these very children. The extra expense thus incurred is borne by the Londonderry Iron Co. and the resident property-holders, while these rich landlords are receiving all the benefit and giving no return for it.

We appeal to all lovers of fair play to know if the action of those who opposed this bill is just, manly or honorable.

Are there to be patches from Ottawa we may look for quite a snail in the Dominion cabinet at the close of the session. The name of Hon. Postmaster-General McLellan is mentioned in connection with the Hon. Governmentship. While we would regret exceedingly the loss of so popular and able a representative, yet we could congratulate the people of the whole province upon the appointment of one so well qualified, worthy and deserving, a requirement from active politics, after a contentious and active parliamentary life of thirty years, having devoted his best days and youthful energies in the service of his country. The beginning of his public life dates back to 1858, when he was the chosen representative to fill the seat vacated by the death of his father, who had represented this county from 38 to April of '58 in the house when convening in Halifax. He was on this his first election, opposed by Peter Archibald. The year following, viz., 1859 being the general election he was again elected. He was re-elected in 1863, and in the memorable election on consideration, in 1867, was again returned, defeating Sir Adams G. Archibald, late Lieut-Governor. In 1869 he was appointed to the senate with railway commissioner-ship, which he held until '81, when on the appointment of Thos. McKay, M. P., to the senate, we were

left without a representative, whereupon he resigned his seat in the Senate and contested the county against Chas. N. Cummings, whom he defeated by a handsome majority. The general election, coming again in '82, he was pitted against P. A. Lawrence, (one of the most intelligent, able and popular men in the (Brit faction), when he was returned with the large majority of 435. Again at the general election in '87 he was returned with the very handsome majority of 627. This election the Grits contested, and in order to give them an extra and early opportunity of testing their popularity, he resigned his seat, and again left the same opponent with about the same majority. During the past few years he has filled the seats (of Minister of Marine and Fisheries, Minister of Finance, and the Postmaster-Generalship) in the Dominion cabinet, reflecting great credit and acknowledged ability on his part. His Budget Speech, while Minister of Finance, was acknowledged to be one of the ablest yet listened to in the house from that department. It is the opinion of all that the government can ill afford to appoint Mr. Hon. J. W. McLellan to the governorship, for the present at least.

If Sir Charles Tupper resigns his seat to again take the High Commissioner-ship, Mr. McLellan will, no doubt, succeed him as Minister of Finance, as he is best qualified and has the thorough knowledge or the business connected with that department.

Our paper for the present will not spare if further comments, but we trust in the near future to give more of a detailed and interesting history of the public life of the Hon. Postmaster-General.

Remarks by Prohibition.

The 4th April 24th, 1888.

To the Editor of the Londonderry Times. Sir.—I am informed, by credible authority, that you are about to re-estate the detestable "Week's Doings" at Acadia Mines. Hoping your first issue will be a grand debut, and that every subsequent issue may increase in the esteem of your patrons, until your subscription list shall cover your entire circulation.

Although not claiming to be an expert in periodical matters, yet I feel sanguine that you will favour me with a small space in the columns of your new journal, in which I shall endeavor to give you a brief description of the workings and theories produced by the several temperance bodies and legal temperance leaders in this city who have attempted to prevent the retailing of the article, by entering actions against certain parties for violations of the Canada Temperance Act, and against other parties for selling contrary to the wording of the Halifax License Statute of 1886.

Those gentlemen persist in the righteousness of their theory, contending that there is nothing in the two acts which conflict with each other; they also insist that we have in this county two laws in operation, both legal and constitutional, and they have a perfect right to introduce and put a license law into operation, against the wishes of a people who, some years ago, by the authority of the Dominion Government, passed an act which prohibits the sale of intoxicating liquors in any form, unless legally dispensed for medicinal purposes.

The late actions against the sellers has caused some parties in this place to become exhilarated and amused, while others are not a little amazed, and look upon such proceedings as a fanciful farce. There is yet another portion of the community who quietly express their views on the situation, by addressing the language of the old Scotch poet, "That the best laid plans of men and mice going after a gale, and which are compositely awaiting the final decision of a higher and more intelligent tribunal than that which presides at the police court at Truro."

The agitation caused by certain prosecutions brought against some of the liquor dealers at Truro who

being instructed by the most eminent legal counsel in the Dominion of Canada, are fully impressed with the idea that they have been persecuted by being unjustly and illegally dealt with. I refer to those who have been prosecuted under the Local License Act of 1886. Mr. Editor, whenever a wrong act is innocently committed, either by accident or from a lack of wisdom, and get it worthy of a due consideration and a proper pardon.

Although I voted for the Canada Temperance Act, (so-called) nevertheless I cannot deal in eccentricities or fanaticisms, neither will I close my eyes against reason, justice, or valid law. I am compelled to confess that I have witnessed instances of excessive temperance zeal, where reason seemed to be destroyed, yet only by parties possessing ordinary brain power and a very limited education. But I fail to see where any apology (if offered) could be accepted from men of culture, who are highly educated, and who are supposed to be endowed with noble natural attainments; also well versed in law, and who are lawyers by profession, and some amongst them who have previously assisted in framing some of the statutes of the country, and are now endeavoring, by word and deed, to subject and place a misconception on the only temperance law in this county, which is valid. It is utterly impossible for the legal functionaries of Truro to be so excessively blind as to be unable to perceive confusions in more ways than referred to.

Almost any twelve-year-old school boy can tell you that the Scott Act was accepted by the people, that it was proclaimed law by the proper authorities, that it was duly gazetted, that parties all over the Dominion have been present for the violation of its provisions, that decisions have been rendered, convictions made, money penalties exacted, and in our own county a certain party was incarcerated in Truro jail, and I regret to state that he was arrested and committed to the Lord's holy Sabbath day, a day on which the petty officials of Economy should have detested their country to a better cause.

However, am earnestly informed, that legal counsel has been procured in the case referred to, and that a deposit has been made by the friends of the party aggrieved, who is anxiously awaiting further developments. Notwithstanding all that has transpired in connection with the Scott Act mentioned, yet these silver-tongued gentry here will tell you that they cannot see any conflict between the Canada Temperance Act and Local License Act, which they have toted up from Halifax, and which they endeavor to cram down the necks of the people of Colchester.

Ask any sane man, who voted for or against the Canada Temperance Act, if he can produce any precedent to such a farce, or the record of any attempt (to say the least) so derogative to the rights and intelligence of the electors of Colchester, which is looked upon by many of the intelligent public as a contemptuous effort to stifle British liberty.

Very correspondent entertain very grave doubts about the constitutionality of the past proceedings at Truro in liquor matters when parties undertake to introduce, against the wishes of the people, a law which permits the sale of intoxicating liquors in a county which passed an act in deadly opposition to its sale, and which act (as far as my knowledge extends) has never as yet been repealed. I do not imagine the necessity of studying law in order to perceive a great confution.

I would gladly hear what the genuine temperance men throughout the county think of the Halifax law, which some legal gentlemen (styling themselves advocates of temperance) would proudly force upon this county, against the wishes of a people who have never (in a legal manner) expressed any dissatisfaction towards the law which they themselves passed, and they alone are the only power to repeal; when anxious so to do, and should the proper application be made I doubt not that every facility for its repeal will be cheerfully granted. For your patience and space I return my sincere thanks, and wish your new enterprise in journalism the utmost success.

GENERAL NEWS.

The bill ratifying the fishery treaty passed the senate yesterday. The returns of the elections in Kent County, Ontario, give Campbell the first candidate, about one-half the majority obtained at the general election of last year. The counties of Bruce, Dufferin, Douglas, Huron, Norfolk, Renfrew and Simcoe, Ont., have voted in favor of the repeal of the Scott Temperance act.

Windsor, May 2.—Tenders for the completion of the Red River Valley railway will be invited by the Manitoba government at the latter end of the week, and it is expected the road will be finished by July first.

Jacob Holles, living in Charlottetown, Calhoun Co., 40 miles from this place, returning home in company with a friend last Wednesday night, April 19, found his wife and three children dead. Four strange men were in the house door, and he shot the men, killing three and severely wounding the fourth.
