ANOTHER FIRE HORROR.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 22.—The Baldwin Theatre caught fire at midnight,

after the conclusion of the play "Secret Service." The fire spread quickly to the

Baldwin Hotel, the theatre and the hotel being part of the same building. The

hotel, which is second only to the Palace in consequence, was crowded with

patrons. As a man was sent all through the house, but the fire burned so rapidly

that some of the guests had to jump for their lives. A Mr. Morris, recently

returned from the Klondike, was hurt in jumping and died in the hospital.

N. D. Noon, of St. Louis, was taken in flames a man in a night shirt clambered

out of an upper window. To those below it seemed as though he had fallen

back into the flames. Eight servants who were on the top floor may have been

burned to death. They and several other employees have not been accounted for.

The interior of the building was still burning like a furnace at midnight. Shortly after the flames broke out two

men were seen at the window of the cupola on the northwest corner of the

building. Several gentlemen on the street volunteered to go to their rescue, but they were prevented by policemen

from doing so.

Soon after two other women were seen in one of the upper story windows and they were seen to jump out of the

building. It was given out that the members of "Secret Service" are all accounted for.

It does not appear that the loss of life will be as great as was at first feared, owing to the warning given to the guests, but at this hour it is impossible to state definitely either as to the number of victims or their names.

The hotel and theatre buildings were owned by F. J. Baldwin, and with the furnishings are estimated to have been worth \$1,500,000. The building was of brick with a high mansard roof and a lofty tower on one corner which looked like a great torch. It illuminated the city and could be seen far at sea.

The firemen had a difficult time in keeping the fire from burning adjacent buildings.
