THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

Are we growing ashamed of the cross of Christ? Is the custom of blessing ourselves before meals, before retiring, on awakening, in temptations, growing stale?

'Blessing themselves' was as fond and familiar a practice among the early Christians as bowing the head at the name of Jesus.

The Christians used the sign of the Cross in all circumstances. Tertullian, speaking for Catholics, wrote in the second century: 'At every fresh step and change of place, whenever we come in or go out, when we put on our sandals or wash, or take our meals, or light our lamps, whether we are about to recline or to sit down, and whenever we begin a conversation, we impress on our forehead the sign of the Cross.'

No sacrament is administered, no benediction imparted without the sign of the Cross.

The sign of the Cross is the most explicit act of faith in the two basic truths of Christianity: The mystery of the adorable Trinity (one God and three divine Persons) and the Incarnation. By saying in the name (not names) we profess our belief in one only God. By saying 'of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Ghost,' we profess our belief in three divine Persons in that one only God.

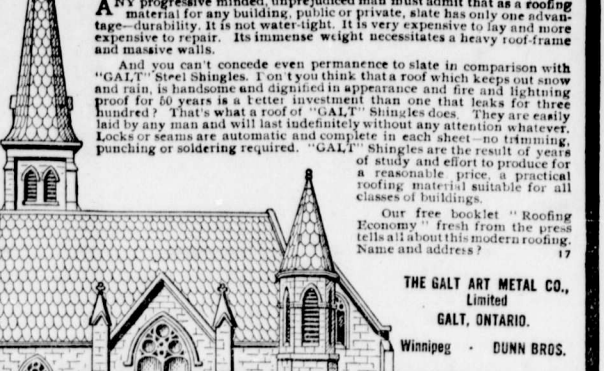
