EDUCATIONAL NOTES.

In Parry Sound District the number of pupils enrolled in 1877, with an average attendance of 88.

The Collingwood Collegiate Institute carried off two out of the seven scholarships offered by the University of Toronto at the late examination.

There are 157 new candidates for teaching certificates in Nova Scotia going for examination this year. It remains to be seen how many are successful in obtaining them.

Rev. Dr. Patterson, of Nova Scotia, the candidate appointed by the Presbyterian General Assembly to raise the \$100,000 fund for Manitoba College, will visit the various parts of the Province of Manitoba before proceeding to the Old Country on his mission.

At a recent meeting of the Hamilton Board of Education, the financial statement for the ensuing year was submitted. It showed that the total receipts were expected to be \$87,066.53, and the expenditure \$87,000, leaving the municipal fund at \$42,000.

The by-law for the purpose of raising \$8,000 for the erection of a High School for the ensuing year was passed on and carried by a majority of 78. There were very small vote cast, there being only 100 for and 100 against.

Forty-eight out of ninety-three candidates were successful at the recent examination for certificates as teachers held in Stratford. The successful candidates numbered 868, and at Napage 25 out of 66 were successful, the large failure to pass being due to the fact that the candidates had not had their papers corrected.

MORE NEW ZEALAND LOANS. The municipality of Dunedin, New Zealand, says the Times in its city article, announce for subscription £250,000 of their Consolidated Five per Cent. Debentures.

The total borrowing powers of the Corporation under this loan are £200,000; but £37,900 is reserved for converting the existing outstanding debt at the option of the holders. The balance of the £212,100 will be used for the purpose of building a new pier and a new wharf.
