


SIR,—I beg to hand you a bulletin dealing with 116 samples purchased by our inspectors, as White Paint, during the month of June of last year. This may be regarded as supplemental to my recent bulletin on the subject of White Lead. (Bull. No. 300.)

In the matter of White Paint we have no standard requirement. This article is generally assumed to consist of white lead, ground in oil, and further diluted with linseed oil and turpentine, with or without so-called dryers, to the proper consistency for convenient application with a brush. White Lead is frequently replaced by oxide or sulphide of zinc, a pigment which while it does not possess the covering power of white lead has some advantages over this. The chief advantage is that where sulphuretted hydrogen is present, the result is to blacken lead paints, while zinc is not affected in this way. We may therefore assume that the normal pigments, which may occur in white paint, that may be regarded as genuine, are either basic carbonate of lead (white lead), or oxide or sulphide of zinc, or a mixture of these.

Twenty-eight (28) samples of this collection are found to contain white lead as their principal pigment. Thirty samples (30) contain zinc oxide or sulphide, and nine (9) samples contain lead and zinc in admixture. If these be regarded as genuine, then sixty-seven (67) samples constituting fifty-eight per cent (58%) of the collection are found to be genuine.

Barytes or sulphate of barium often called Heavy Spar is a much cheaper substance than either lead or zinc pigments. It is much used as a filler in white paint and cannot be regarded as an adulterant if the fact of its presence is declared on the label. Thirty-five (35) samples are found to consist chiefly of barytes so far as the pigment is concerned. Fourteen (14) others contain large amounts of barytes in admixture with more or less lead or zinc. All these samples may be regarded as questionable since the presence of the cheaper articles is not declared on the label, nor indicated in any way to the purchaser.

The following statement recapitulates what I have said:—

Inasmuch as we have no legal standard for white paint I cannot ascribe adulteration in a legal sense to any of these samples; but the work now put on record will be of use to the public in making known the character of white paint as offered in the Canadian Market.

I beg to recommend publication of this report as Bulletin No. 301.
