The third will be on the 22d day of July.---The Moon will be eclipsed at 10b. 37m. in the morning.---Invisible.

The Fourth will be on the 5th day of August.---The Sun will be eclipsed at 10b. 45m. in the morning.---Invisible.

The Fifth will be on the 23d day of December.---The Sun will be eclipsed at 7b. 42m. in the afternoon.---Invisible.
