**An Act to disunite the United Counties of Richmond and Wolfe for the purposes of representation in the Provincial Parliament.**

**W**HEREAS the great extent of territory, the geographical position and the population of the United Counties of Richmond and Wolfe render it expedient and necessary that these counties should be disunited for the purposes of representation in the Provincial Parliament; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: .

Preamble.

I. From and after the \_\_\_\_\_ the united counties of Richmond and Wolfe shall be disunited for the purposes of representation in the Provincial Parliament, and the said County of Richmond and the said County of Wolfe shall each be entitled, empowered and required, at the first general election of representatives to serve in said Provincial Parliament after the said day, or on the first vacancy in the representation of the said United Counties after the said day, to elect a fit and proper person to represent such county in the Provincial Parliament aforesaid.

Counties disunited after \_\_\_\_\_, each to send a member to Parliament after the said day.
