1861.

An Act to confirm and establish the Northern limit of North Street, between Clarence Street and Richmond Street, in the City of London.

WHEREAS the Incumbent and Churchwardens of St. Pauls Church, in the City of London, in the county of Middlesex, have petitioned for an Act to define and settle the southern limit of the block of land on which the said Church of St. Paul stands, which last mentioned limit also forms the northern limit of North Street, between Clarence Street and Richmond Street, in the City of London. Preamble.

And Whereas, by an order in Council in that behalf, issued in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Three, the block of land on which the said Church of St. Paul stands, was granted as a site for the said Church, and was accordingly, in the said year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Three, enclosed with a fence for that purpose, and has ever since remained so inclosed and in the occupation and possession of the said Church of St. Paul; and in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Six, in pursuance of the said order in Council, Letters patent issued for the said land, describing the same as "That plot of ground on which the Church of St. Paul stands."

And Whereas the southern limit of the said land was, when the said land was enclosed as aforesaid in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-Three, and has ever since continued, and now is, one hundred feet distant from the southern limit of North Street and parallel thereto.

And Whereas it is expedient that an Act be passed to confirm and establish the said northern limit of North Street.

Therefore, Her Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada enacts as follows:

1. The said northern limit of North Street, between Clarence Street and Richmond Street, which limit also forms the southern limit of the said block of land on which the said Church of St. Paul stands, as the same was and is fenced as aforesaid, shall be distant from the southern limit of North Street one hundred feet and parallel thereto. Northern limit of North Street defined.

2. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
