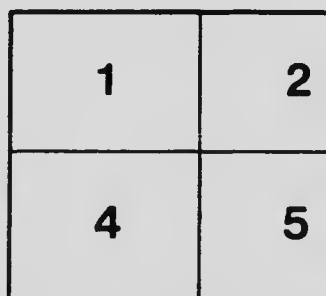

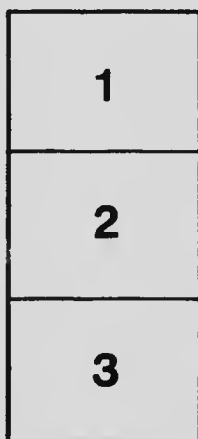

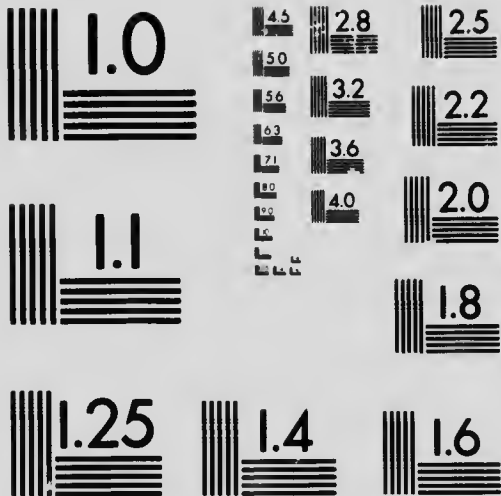

Carlyle once wrote to a friend: "Prayer is and remains the native and deepest impulse of the soul of man."

Yet, in these latter times, it has been said, "all the characteristic enthusiasms of our day cluster around work."

Family Prayers are seldom used, even it is to be feared in professedly Christian homes, and, as a necessary result, the habit of private prayer must suffer.

I welcome therefore this little booklet, compiled by my friend, Miss Knox, as a means under the Holy Spirit of God, of reviving the spirit and practice of private prayer.

Intended primarily for the use of students, I am convinced that very many older persons will find it helpful. Simple and practical in style, deeply devotional, and true in its spirit to the teaching of God's Holy Word, I heartily commend it to young and old.

FOREWORD.

The following Prayers (with thoughts and phrases interwoven from varying sources), have been written in view of the difficulties of to-day and with a special longing after reality. We are realizing better than ever that if we would pray effectively we must think effectively, and that Prayer is *not* a magic charm, *not* a mere grasping after the good things of life, *not* a shirking of the ill, but something far grander, far nobler.

What then is Prayer? True Prayer is a "practice of the presence of God," such as that of the greatest of our Scotch forefathers in the Maritime Provinces, of whom it is recorded that "they saw and felt God everywhere." But prayer goes deeper, and may be defined as a deliberate opening of the life to God, a determined seeking to be ruled and swayed down to the minutest detail by a power infinitely stronger, infinitely purer than our own. It is entering into the presence chamber of an Almighty Father and Friend; it is clasping the Hand which leads us across the troublous waters of life to the harbour "where no storm can come, where the green swell is in the haven dumb, and out of the swing of the sea."

Prayer may be unwritten or written. Unwritten Prayer lies first in a personal confession of sin, a daily standing at the foot of the Cross till, like Christian, the burden rolls away and we see it no more. But true Prayer goes further. It is a song of praise when the soul, set free from the consciousness of sin, is at wing on its flight to God. Then further still, it is

placing the day's anxiety, the day's opportunity for self and for others in the hand of an all-wise Counsellor and Friend.

Written Prayer can never take the place of unwritten, that is to say, spontaneous prayer, but it can and does serve its own end by putting into words what we all feel and need but cannot at the moment readily express.

But all Prayer, written or unwritten, finds its completion in the spirit of the Lord's Prayer, the prayer which breathes a foretaste of the length, breadth, depth and height of the love of Christ, the "Our Father," the first prayer lisped at our mother's knee, the "Our Father," the last prayer which instinctively lingers on our dying lips as we pass into the immediate presence of God.

If any are weak give me strength to help them; if any blind, give me light to guide them unto Thee. Through Jesus Christ my Lord. Amen.

SUNDAY EVENING.

HOLY FATHER, in the quiet of this evening when all the world over men and women are thinking of Thee, let Thy calm descend upon us, we pray Thee. Be with all at home and far away who are praying for us and for whom we would now pray. Keep us near Thee throughout the coming week, as Thou hast kept us to-day. Be beside us at each turn of the road. Let Thy healing touch rest upon any who are in sorrow, sickness or suffering. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

MOST GRACIOUS FATHER, I thank Thee for the message of love which Thou hast sent me this day, and for the pardon which Thou hast promised to all who truly turn to Thee. Thou hast been with me in Thy House and at home. Lift my thoughts to the time when I shall be eternally with Thee in the home which Thou art preparing for me. I cannot fathom this Thy wondrous tenderness and love in calling me, but I can believe Thy promise, and I know that Thou art my Father and my Friend. I long to glorify Thee and to finish the work which Thou hast given me to do. Into Thy hands I commit my spirit this night. Keep me, oh keep me, King of kings, beneath Thine own almighty wings. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

MONDAY MORNING.

GOD, by the power of Thy indwelling Spirit, strengthen me for a clear discharge of the week's work now before me. Lead me hour by hour for I have no Guide but Thee. Help me to press forward, caring little for my own honour or credit, but greatly for the fulfilling of Thy task. I am learning and working in the great School of Life. Thou hast called me to improve the talents which Thou hast given me. Teach me to look forward to the ever-approaching hour when Thou wilt return and call me to Thy side to hear the lesson which Thou Thyself hast set me. If things go ill with me, keep me patient and cheerful; if well, steady and quiet. May I live in kindly fellowship with my comrades, working together in honour and clean mirth. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

ALmighty GOD, pour into our hearts such love toward Thee that we, loving Thee above all things, may seek Thee and Thee only. Help us to cast aside useless forms and shadows, to worship Thee in spirit and in truth. Give us an abiding awe and reverence of Thy Holy Name. Let no light, irreverent or profane word cross our lips. May we be consecrated to Thee and to Thy service, this day and forever. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

MONDAY EVENING.

MY HEAVENLY FATHER, I draw near to Thee, once again, to thank Thee for Thy loving care and protection during the past day. Thou hast given me my health and strength, my reason and understanding, my work and power to do it. Forgive the carelessness, self-seeking, and forgetfulness which have marred and hindered it. Accept whatever I have tried to do which has been well-pleasing in Thy sight. Take me into Thy care and keeping through the hours of the night. Through the long day I have laboured, Lord, Oh give me now repose. For Jesus Christ's sake. Amen.

Ⓞ GREAT CAPTAIN of our Salvation, Who knowest the evil on every side and the need of outstanding leaders for the right, look down upon me and upon my comrades now training at school and at home. Help us to make such a wise use of these swiftly passing days that faithful and strong leaders may be raised up from among us who will one day be mighty in helping to turn the tide of evil and in doing battle against all deceit, hypocrisy and lies. The time is short, Lord Jesus, return in power and reign among us forever. Amen.

TUESDAY MORNING.

ALMIGHTY GOD, in Whom we live and move and have our being, Thou who art about my path by day and around my bed by night, keep me upright in thought, word and deed. Help me to realize Thy Fatherly presence everywhere, and see the tokens of Thy love around me. Let me live in the light of Thy countenance and rejoice in the sunshine of Thy love. Lift me onto the hilltops, away from the valley where I shall never find Thee, and beyond the mists of my selfishness and cherished sins. My lot in life is uncertain, Thou mayest call me from the quiet shelter of home into the hurried sphere of outside life. Grant that however busied my hand may be, my heart and mind may heavenward ascend and with Thee continually dwell. Give me an abiding longing for Thy truth, and a burning desire to love and serve Thee, till I reach Thy presence and find the perfect joy and peace of the home above. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

WEDNESDAY EVENING.

⓪ UR FATHER, far away yet ever near, grant us this evening a greater fear and reverence of Thy Holy Name. ⓪ RD JESUS, Who hast taught us that him that overcometh Thou wilt make a pillar in Thy Temple, grant, in the midst of wearying drudgery or sharp temptation that we may catch a vision of the purpose of our life and yield ourselves as living stones to be wrought into whatsoever shape Thou the Great Architect mayest design, and be built into Thy temple, according to Thy will. For Thy Name's sake. Amen.

THURSDAY MORNING.

ALMIGHTY GOD, the light returns and brings its daily round of duties. Make me humble enough to do small things gladly for Thee, alert and brave enough to undertake greater things if Thou shouldst choose them. I long to recognize Thy voice wherever and whenever I may hear it. Keep me from putting any obstacle in the way of Thy kind and loving hand. I have faults, help me to see them and strive against them, instead of idly thinking and dwelling upon the faults of others. Thou knowest me through and through, far better than I know myself. I trust Thee and listen to Thy voice. I will walk patiently step by step, content to wait for the time when Thou presently wilt make plain the meaning of all that puzzles and confuses me. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

⊙ MOST MERCIFUL FATHER, who wilt forgive and put far away the sins of all who repent and turn to Thee, free me from the evil which at times hangs heavy over me and would hide the sunshine of Thy face. Especially put away from me all bitterness and unkindness. Let the words of my mouth and the imaginations of my heart be always acceptable in Thy sight, O Lord, my Strength and my Redeemer. Amen.

THURSDAY EVENING.

ALMIGHTY FATHER, give me grace to cast away the works of darkness and to put on the armour of light. Enable me as Thy faithful soldier and servant to resist temptation and having done all to stand. By the power of Thy Holy Spirit help me to be loyally true, and to make known Thy love in my daily calling to those around me, and to others far away, according to my opportunity. Teach me day by day what Thou wouldst have me do. Show me how by my prayers, my gifts and my daily living, I may set forward Thy glory and hasten the coming of Thy Kingdom. Through Jesus Christ my Lord. Amen.

ALMIGHTY FATHER, it is not night if Thou be near. Look down in mercy upon all whom I love, especially all now absent from me. Give Thine angels charge over them and over me, to keep us in all our ways. If it be Thy holy will bring us soon together again, but if our callings still lie far apart, draw us daily nearer Thee, looking for the time when in Thy heavenly home we shall rejoice with Thee forever. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

FRIDAY MORNING.

THOU SAVIOUR OF THE WORLD, Who hast loved Thine own even unto the end, Thou Saviour Whose hands of mercy and pity were outstretched upon the Cross for us, save us, and help us, we humbly beseech Thee, O Lord. Grant that we may lose our lives to save them for Thee, that we may sacrifice to conquer for Thee. We offer ourselves, body, soul and spirit, a living sacrifice in Thy service. Cast out the lurking love of sin, the wayward will, the anxious doubt, which too often hinders and paralyzes us. Prepare us at Thy will for work in the mission field or at home. Thy vows are upon us, O Christ, help us to be content to press forward, unmoved by idle criticism, so long as Thou knowest the way that we tread, joyous so long as Thy love is over our head. Amen.

ALmighty GOD, Who hast bidden us serve Thee with a perfect heart and with a willing mind, in the urgency of our duty let us hear Thy voice saying "Fear not for I am with Thee." Make us realize that Thou hast a message for every one of us regarding our daily life at home, in the street, and at work. Grant that wherever that work may lead us we may be swift to hear, slow to retort, slow to wrath. Help us to toil gladly, rejoicing in Thy presence and in the work which Thou hast allotted us. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

FRIDAY EVENING.

ALMIGHTY AND EVERLASTING GOD, Who art always more ready to hear than we to pray, I turn to Thee in Thy great love this night. I know only too well that I have sinned against Thee in thought, word and deed, and I fear, but for Thy eternal promise which rings out over land and sea, "Him that cometh unto me I will in no wise cast out." Remembering that promise, Father, I come. Thou wilt not cast me out. My faith is weak, doubts and fears too often draw me away from Thee, but Thou wilt not let me go. Lord, I believe, help Thou mine unbelief. Let the sunshine of Thy love dispel the lingering evil in my heart. Through Jesus Christ my Lord. Amen.

⊙ **THOU TRUE LIGHT**, that lightest every man that cometh into the world, touch my heart and lighten my understanding. Thou art pure; teach me to hate all profane books and evil talk, and above all, any moment in which an impure thought has clouded my mind and threatened to separate my soul from Thee. Thou art Love; keep me from murmuring at my lot in life or coveting gifts which Thou hast seen fit to withhold. Thou art Truth; teach me to hate every kind of underhand dealing and to strive to lead a purer, truer life. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

SATURDAY MORNING.

ALMIGHTY GOD, Whose truth unchanged has ever stood, and Who savest those who on Thee call, cast about us this day, we beseech Thee, a fence which the Evil One cannot pass. Clothe us with the armour which his darts cannot pierce. Enable us to work diligently and faithfully, not with eye service but in singleness of heart, remembering that without Thee we can do nothing, and that in Thy fear is the beginning of wisdom. Thou art our Judge, and to Thee we look and to Thee only in all our saying and doing. We ask this for Christ's sake. Amen.

ALMIGHTY FATHER, Who hast promised that Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on Thee, grant me Thy peace, the peace of sin forgiven. Grant me a calm and quiet trust in Thee and a stern mastery of my own will. In the midst of anxiety keep me from self, in stress of work from speaking impatiently, in difficulty, from having no time for the needs and interests of others. With a heart at leisure from itself may I soothe and sympathize. At peace with Thee may I be at peace with all around me. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

SATURDAY EVENING.

ALMIGHTY GOD, Who savest by Thy right hand all who put their trust in Thee, I lay at Thy feet another week's work, such as it is, with all the sins that need Thy forgiveness and with all the flaws that need the mending of Thy gracious hand. Help me day by day to remember that the time is short, and that this earth is not an idle paradise into which I have wandered by chance, but a battlefield ordained of old, in which each must play his part and the stakes are life and death. Enable me to take the side of the right and to go fearlessly forward. Let each week-end, as it passes, find me and my comrades looking beyond the dark outline of the hills of time, faithful to our charge, one step nearer Thee. Take us all into Thy holy keeping, granting us in this world knowledge of Thy truth and in the world to come life everlasting. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

HEAVENLY FATHER, Who hast prepared for us a city eternal in the heavens where we may abide with Thee forever, help us to look forward quietly to the night, ever drawing nearer, when we shall put aside our well-worn tools, without a sigh, and step forward to the better work and the more joyful rest of our home above. Thither lead us, our King and our God. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
