FIGHT IN MADAGASCAR

ADMIRAL PIERS REPORTS A VICTORY

A Heavily-Summoned Meeting of the English Cabinet - No Further News of the Straggle

Paris, July 13.—The French consul at Zanzibar has telegraphed that he has no knowledge of the occurrence in Tamatave complained of by the English.

Admiral Piers reports that he received a night attack on June 23 and another on July 6. The Hova loss was heavy. The French had one killed. He does not mention any trouble with the English consul at Tamatave.

London, July 13.—Lord Fitzmaurice stated in the commons this afternoon that the government had no intention of increasing the number of men-of-war in the waters of Madagascar.

A heavily-summoned cabinet council was held in Mr. Gladstone's room in the commons this afternoon. The meeting is believed to have been called for the consideration of matters relative to affairs in Madagascar.

THE NEW SUEZ CANAL

Opposition in Parliament to the Project

London, July 13.—In the commons this afternoon Mr. Childers in reply to Sir Stafford Northcote said the canal agreement would be submitted by a motion to the effect that the sum to be loaned to the company by the government for building a new canal be charged on the consolidated fund.

Mr. Childers said that he had no objection to the canal agreement, but that he had some objections to the financial arrangements proposed.

Mr. William Lowther, Liberal, spoke in opposition to the canal scheme.

At a crowded meeting of merchants and shipowners at Lloyd's to-day, resolutions were passed strongly objecting to the agreement between Messrs. De Lesseps and the government on financial, commercial and political grounds.

The lord mayor was asked to call a meeting in order to make a further report on Mr. Childers's statement.

The deputations stated the government had made the best bargain possible with De Lesseps. He said they were buyers from not an anxious seller, and had obtained solid advantages for British shipowners and consumers.

De Lesseps in an interview declared he was indifferent whether England accepted the canal agreement or not.

CONDENSED CALIBRES

The emperor has given his sanction to the Prussian church bill.

It is reported that Messrs. Mason and Mearns have submitted to the Board of Trade the corrupt practices bill passed through the committee stage in the commons last night.

The steamer Danby has been partly raised. The corpses in the hold will be removed to-morrow.

Spain has instituted a system compulsory of inspection of all vessels arriving at Spanish ports from England.

Spain is in a state of anarchy. The French have hanged many marauders, bands of whom are still stirring in the outpost.

The Imperial government will probably refuse to enter upon legislation touching the cattle diseases at this session of parliament.

RIOTING OCCURRED AT NEWBY LAST NIGHT

The rioting was powerless. The mobs assembled all persons supposed to be orange-men.

The miners' strike at Cannock, Staffordshire, is ended. There are signs that the ironmen who recently struck will soon resume work.

Dreyfus de La France and Judd of La Lorraine fought a duel with words near Paris yesterday. Dreyfus was wounded in the right side.

The house of lords has dismissed with costs the appeal in the case of McHenry v. Jewett and the New York, Lake Erie and Western railroad company. The suit involved \$285,000.

THE GUELPH LOTTERY

GUELPH, July 13.—The opera house lottery has been abandoned. The promoters sent word a few days ago to a large Toronto firm to whom they had given their work to cancel all their orders for printing. Their printing bill amounted to several hundred dollars as they were unable to complete it last night. The other preliminary expenses make quite a large bill and the promoters do not like the idea of having to foot them. But the whole thing is now completely killed.

OVER NIAGARA FALLS.

The Foolhardy Project of Captain Matthew Webb

BUFFALO, N. Y., July 13.—A dispatch from Mr. Anbury says Capt. Webb proposes to go over Niagara Falls on July 21. The captain says he intends to make an attempt in a rubber ball of four feet and one-half in diameter and one-fourth of an inch thick. He proposes to enter this ball, after which it will be closed airtight. The air will then be forced in the ball until it will bear any outside pressure to which it may be subjected. The ball will be carried by the river and allowed to float over the falls. He is confident that the scheme will be successfully accomplished. Whether it is not \$10,000 and percentage of admissions to the bridge, parks, etc., will be paid to Capt. Webb or his heirs. A point has been selected in the river where a ball, when cast into the river, will be carried to the crest of the falls in about twenty feet deep. To determine whether or not life would be damaged by the water, a dog was enclosed and sent over the falls and came out alive. In response to a question the captain said he expected to be shaken up, but he had been shaken up many times before and guessed he could stand it. At least he would be ready for dinner when the passage was made.

BRADSTREET'S WEEKLY REPORT

New York, July 13.—Special telegrams to Bradstreet from leading trade centres show that while the customary midsummer dullness prevails in various departments of business, the gains heretofore noted have been well maintained. There have been several notable disturbances in industrial lines, but a noticeable falling away, such as is customary at this season of the year. At the extreme east there are signs that the autumn buying is beginning. In the wheat market an unusual amount of manipulation has taken place, but the whole wheat has declined. Indian corn has been firmer and the demand has been steadier, but not sufficiently widespread to affect the situation as a whole. The market for cotton has been quiet and notations have been sustained. The corn belt points to a relatively better crop of Indian corn. The latest telegraphic news from the West shows a falling away of wheat to Bradstreet's from the north-west encourages the belief in the prospects of a good crop. Provisions have declined, owing in part to unfavorable rumors from abroad. Petroleum has declined, though its statistical position is unchanged. Iron remains firm. Ocean freight is dull.

There were 140 failures in the United States reported during the past week, 4 more than the preceding week, 15 more than the corresponding week of 1882, and 50 more than the same week of 1881.

AN ESCAPED LUNATIC'S DEED

DVIOR, Ill., July 13.—Andrew White, formerly a wealthy citizen of Chicago, has been living on a stock farm near here. Overwork made him insane and he was sent to an asylum. He had the hallucination that he had been imprisoned by his family. A week ago he escaped, bought a revolver, and went home. Yesterday morning he shot his wife and children, and then himself. He had been in the asylum for several months. His wife and children, one after the other, died. He then dragged all the bodies into the dining-room, laid them on a table, sat down in a chair, and shot himself dead.

A FALL OF 3000 FEET

At Texarkana, Ark., on July 6, F. T. Monte, the well-known athlete, suspended on a rope, made an ascension, such as a fire balloon. After the aerial ship had ascended about 2000 feet it caught fire. Monte hung on to the ropes until they caught fire and then he fell. He landed on a pile of corn, but was not hurt, except that his hands were badly burned. Over two thousand persons hurried to the spot where Monte remained for some time. He was carried to a hospital, where he recovered his senses there was great surprise.

A SCHOOLSCHOOL STRUCK BY LIGHTNING

BURTON, W. Va., July 13.—A heavy thunder storm occurred at Underhill this afternoon. The schoolschool was struck by lightning. All the children were more or less injured, some remaining unconscious several minutes. The floor of the school room was torn up, the walls and ceiling wrecked. HYDROPHOBIA

SAG HARBOR, L. I., July 13.—Joseph Rogers, aged 5, a scholar at Brooklyn convent, while on a visit home at Brooklyn last November, was bitten on the cheek by a dog. The wound disappeared. A few mornings since he was taken with convulsions, barked like a dog, and died in thirty-six hours.

MONTREAL, July 13.—The coroner's inquiry into the death of Chapman on the Grand Trunk railway has elicited evidence that the deceased was killed by the iron lid of the stove thrown from the car. Angus McCarthy, a member of the 88th regiment, testified that he was standing beside the prisoner McAnley when he threw the iron, and he saw deceased struck with it and fall immediately after.
